

A LETTER FROM FATHER COREY/GENERAL NEWS

Dear Parishioners,

I hope and pray you are braving the Fall weather well! Fall has always been my favorite time of year, and it finally feels like it has arrived with chilly weather and changing leaves!

In parish news, the Annual Diocesan Appeal is upon us! As Catholics, it is our duty to support the work of the Church. Ideally, we all should be giving at least 10% of our income to God through charity and care for the church. One possible breakdown that I have found helpful of this is 5% to your parish, 4% to charities of your choice, and 1% to the Annual Diocesan Appeal.

As you may know, each parish is assessed a certain amount based on our annual income. Our current assessment is 14% of our annual, which amounts to \$25,185. Any of this money we don't fulfill would have to come out of our savings, which is obviously undesirable, but on the flip-side, any money we make over the top comes back to us "tax-free", in other words, we won't get taxed on it from the Diocese in next year's assessment. In light of this, this is the perfect time to give! The ADA goes to support the functioning of the Diocese and the bulk of that is to support seminarians in education. In fact, the past three years I was studying canon law, my studies and my income were completely dependent on the ADA. So the past three years you have been supporting me and didn't even know it! So please pray about this and please be as generous as you can! This is a perfect time to reassess how much you give, remembering that God will always give us one hundredfold on what we give to Him! Thank you for your generosity and support!

With the parish secretary's due date fast approaching, we will be seeing the office hours fluctuate more in the coming months. The office will be experiencing closings on the following dates:


