



I am the bread of life. Your ancestors ate the manna in the desert, but they died; this is the bread that comes down from heaven so that one may eat it and not die." Jn 6:48-50



This is a popular time of the year for vacationing and time away. Very early on in my seminary formation I remember hearing the phrase, “there’s no vacation from a vocation” and it has stuck with me ever since.

We use the term vocation quite liberally, but the Catholic understanding of the term suggests a call from the Lord that is permanent. We speak of the universal call to holiness — that everyone has the vocation to be a saint, and this pursuit never ceases. But even our particular vocations — whether it be as a priest, consecrated person, or the call to marriage — these vocations never cease. A priest never stops being a priest, as we hear in Scripture, “you are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek” (Hebrews 7:17). A person who has consecrated their life to God and has taken vows never ceases to be a consecrated person.

Similarly, the marital vows are permanent and indissoluble. A spouse never ceases being a spouse, regardless of what secular society might say. On top of that, any parent will tell you that their call is permanent. Sometimes that call is demanding, other times it is a consolation, but it never ceases. I think there’s a particular way in which mothers carry out this vocational call. I think we can probably all agree that moms never stop being moms!

To have a vocation necessarily means that the call is permanent. Unlike a passion, a hobby, an act of service, which is for a time, there is never a time when your vocation stops. While vacation is often a time to get away from the usual routine, to enjoy some rejuvenation or relaxation, there is no vacation from a vocation. Why? Because our vocation is the way in which we are called to grow in love. Our sole purpose in life is to love God above all else and our neighbor as ourselves. In other words, our purpose in life is to grow in love until that love comes to perfection. Our vocation, put simply, is the way that we achieve this. It is the way in which God seeks to cultivate love in your soul so that you might be prepared to dwell with God, who is love itself, for eternity.

There may be times when the demand of our vocation seems heavy, fatiguing, even frustrating. But it is even, and often especially, in these times that the Lord is forming your heart to love. When your spouse or children demand a love from you that is seemingly beyond what you can handle naturally, it is so that you might be stretched beyond your natural abilities by God’s supernatural grace. When the demands of our vocation shed light on our weaknesses and deficiencies, it serves to help us know how the Lord is forming us to grow in virtue and in love, and to root out what is sinful in us.

Time away is important — by all means, take time off! Relax, enjoy summer, but always remember — there is no vacation from a vocation!

St. Jerome School Needs Your Pig Receipts



Please save your Fox Brothers Piggly Wiggly receipts. Our school receives a 1% cash rebate for all valid Piggly Wiggly receipts returned through this program. All receipts must be from one of the nine Fox Brothers Piggly Wiggly stores: Oconomowoc, Hartland, Hubertus, Jackson, Slinger, Hartford, Saukville, Port Washington, or West Bend. Safeguarding All God’s Family

Per the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Office, all persons requiring training (teachers, catechists, teacher aides, health room, playground, school parents and school volunteers) should register for one of the virtual training sessions until in-person training can be safely resumed. **This is a mandatory one-time training for EVERYONE over 18 years of age — including moms AND dads — who works/volunteers in any capacity with minors in Catholic schools or parishes.** *NOTE: All school parents are required to take this training.



To register for an upcoming virtual training session (available in English or Spanish), go to <http://Milwaukee.CMGconnect.org>

You will need to register for a new account with your name, a username and password; then on the next page under “Initial Live Training Only — Safe Environment Curriculum” click on “Start Curriculum” to register for the online training session of your choice. (Note: At this time there are nine virtual sessions to choose from scheduled in August.)

This training must be completed PRIOR to volunteering in any way with our St. Jerome school or faith formation children.

As of June 1, 2020, all safe environment education training sessions will be conducted virtually in accordance with the guidelines laid out in the Catholic Comeback matrix. Participants will register for a session using the same process as an in-person session, and will be emailed the session log-in information 48 hours prior to the session. 
