

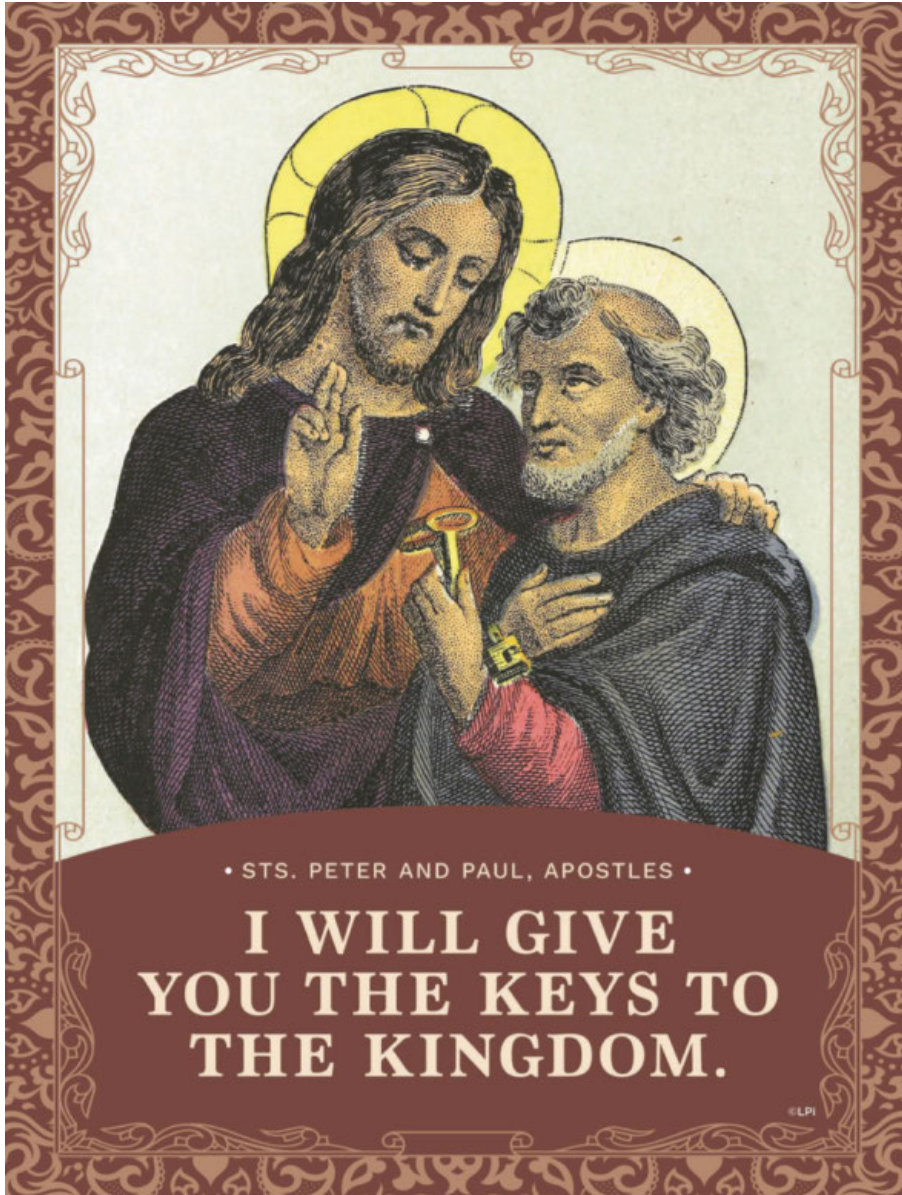

New Associate Pastor

Father Dan Janasik grew up in New Berlin, WI where he attended grade school at Holy Apostles School. He attended Catholic Memorial High School in Waukesha. Following graduation, he entered Marquette University where he double-majored in accounting and theology, initially leading him into a position in public accounting.



It was then that Fr. Dan discerned a call to the priesthood and attended St. Francis de Sales Seminary in Milwaukee. He was ordained to the Priesthood in 2009 at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist in Milwaukee. His first priestly assignment was at St. Francis Borgia Parish in Cedarburg from 2009-2012.

Father Dan has been the Pastor of St. Leonard Parish in Muskego for the past 13 years since 2012. Some recent health struggles led to the decision to step back from the role as Pastor and its administrative responsibilities in order to focus more on the basics of priestly ministry as an Associate Pastor.

"Quo Vadis Domine?"

"Where are you going, Lord?" These words spoken in the Apocryphal Acts of Peter highlight a famous legend about St. Peter, fleeing Rome during a time of persecution.

As he traveled along the Appian Way (a major road leading into the city), Peter encountered the risen Christ and posed this question. Christ responds, "I am going to Rome to be crucified again." Peter, at this moment, is fleeing the persecution that eventually leads to his martyrdom, and Christ is stepping into that persecution, taking not only the place of Peter but also remaining in solidarity with the other Christians who are facing death under Emperor Nero. Peter then turns around and returns to Rome, martyred with Paul in 64 A.D. The whole life of the first Pope was filled with "turnings around", whether on the Sea of Tiberius when he recanted his threefold rejection of Jesus on Good Friday, or that initial call where he left his nets behind to follow Jesus for the next three years.

Lest we forget, Paul had his moments that necessitated a "turning around" as well. From the moment of Paul's conversion on the road to Damascus, he discovers a new path forward, on which he would face trial, hardship, and struggle. Persecuted on the journey, imprisoned in Rome, beaten, flogged, and finally beheaded, Paul was not afraid — "already being poured out like a libation..." as he says, "I have competed well; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith." (2 Tim 4:6-8.). Paul lost everything in his Christian journey, his place as a leading Pharisee, his credibility as a Roman, and finally, his life. Christ's call to Paul necessitates the same sacrifice that Peter had posed to him by Jesus outside Rome, "Are you willing to follow me?"

If we often look at our lives, they are filled with invitations from the Lord Jesus, invitations to big things and little things, easy things and difficult things. More often than not, we can hear things like the challenges from the beatitudes, the invitations of the lives of the Saints, and the struggles we face in our own lives to follow the Lord faithfully. This can often elicit the question Peter posed in Rome so long ago, **Quo vadis, domine?** The Lord's invitation to us can seem mysterious and difficult. Today, we can take inspiration from these two great Saints, martyred together, celebrated together, who magnify the call of the Christian to follow the Lord, no matter where He calls.

Sts. Peter and Paul, Pray for us!

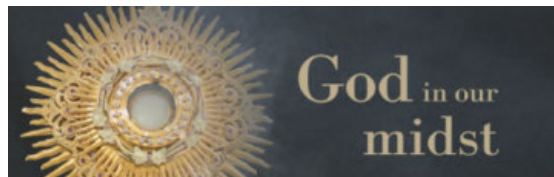

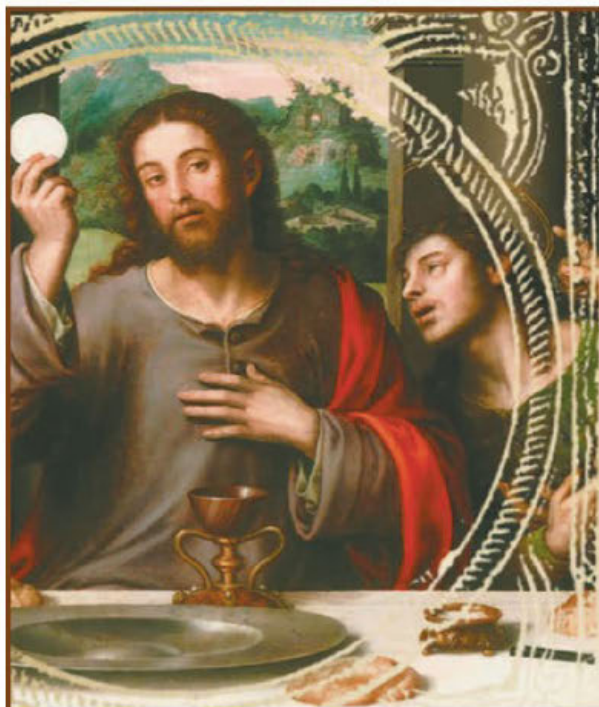


Women of the Parish
