PASTORAL MESSAGE FROM FR. PAUL FLISS



Merry Christmas One and All! The gospel for Mass on Christmas day ends with the most important verse of the passage: “And the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us, and we have seen his glory!” This reality changes everything. The love of the Father is made visible to us through the love of the Son. We now know the truth of God and how the Father always wanted us to be united with Us through the Son.

I don't know how many of you have celebrated Christmas away from family or friends. The one time I did was when I was in Thailand. The strange thing is that Christmas Day itself was the quietest day of the month. The students at the Hmong Center were all home with their families, and so it was Fr Harry Thiel, myself, and the teacher/catechists and their families that were present at the Hmong center. We celebrated Mass, and then shared a wonderful meal together. The Hmong Center took care of 43 Hmong Catholic communities which were in Hmong villages up at the peaks of the mountains. For the month of December and the first two weeks of January, we visited all the communities, hearing confessions, celebrating Mass, sharing a meal and providing Christmas entertainment for the villages. There was no snow, but there were Nativity sets and Christmas trees everywhere. It was fun to experience another culture's celebration of Christmas, but at the end of the day, I did miss snow, and midnight Mass, and being with family. As we gather now in this Christmas season, I invite everyone to look for Jesus in each other. He has made his dwelling among us, and within us. Let us celebrate this deepest truth and greatest gift. Have a great time with family and friends.

As we said our goodbyes, not even attempting to hold back the tears at this point, my mother did her best to console her youngest child, her homebody daughter who stayed in the same zip code for high school and college. “Oh Lauren, it's only two years and then you'll be home....” Oh Jenny, have you ever met the good people of Sheboygan? You can't leave them after two years. They know how to tug at your heartstrings. Thank you, dear friends, for tugging at my heartstrings, welcoming me into your home, and allowing me to continue to serve this community. It is an honor and a gift I cherish!

Is Your loved one in the Hospital or in a Nursing Home Or Homebound?

It also means that even though patients are asked about their church during the admission process, no one from the hospital or nursing home will contact the parish.

Committee and Commission Spotlight: Elizabeth Ministry Program

Why do we pray for Elizabeth Ministry Prayer Requests at Mass?

Our Southside Catholic Parishes participate in the Rosebud Program of Elizabeth Ministry. The Rosebud Program is a beautifully unique way to show respect for the dignity and worth of all life. This program helps our parishes identify, pray for, and support those who are:

- pregnant, (pink rose and prayer card)
- celebrating birth or adoption, (red rose and prayer card)
- grieving miscarriage, stillbirth, abortion, infant or child death, (white)
- wanting to become pregnant or adopt, (yellow)
- grandparents, (purple)
- facing troubled times, (blue).

How It Works

Each of our parishes has an Elizabeth Ministry display including a Rosebud Program "Blessing Bouquet" and related materials. A person selects an appropriate colored rose from a basket, fills out the attached tag, and places the rose into the "Blessing Bouquet". Our parishioners pray for all these prayer requests each week as part of the intercessions at Mass. If contact information is added to the prayer card, an Elizabeth Minister may contact the person to offer support and additional information.

The display also includes prayer cards appropriate to each issue that may be taken home for personal prayer and meditation. If you are interested in helping with this ministry, please contact Deacon John Gavin at 920-918-5310.

At Immaculate Conception, the Elizabeth Ministry display is in the day chapel. At St. Peter Claver, the display is in the prayer room by the Sacristy. At Ss Cyril & Methodius, the display is in the back of Church near the lending library.
