PASTORAL MESSAGE FROM FR. SUBI THOMAS



We celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord this weekend. On the Feast of the Epiphany, the three wise men give up their palaces, power, and possessions; they say farewell to the most cherished people in the lives to pursue a deeper calling. And from there, they proceed on one mission, they focus on one star, and it leads them to one stable, where they encounter one person, in whom their wildest dreams are fulfilled.

This feast invites us to focus on the “one thing,” Christ, and that all other pursuits mean nothing in comparison.

How do we find Jesus and honor Jesus today? Especially in the remote corners of communities where He can be found in the very people who have been counted out. People of color, women, the disabled and abandoned, the homeless and helpless, those different from us.

The World needs another Epiphany. An encounter with folks of every persuasion to see in their hearts another Christ and do him homage. YES, Epiphany asks us to see the divine in each person, and to show them honor and respect. Each of us needs an Epiphany moment to shape our hearts and have the awareness to perceive the Divine within each person and act from that clarity of understanding. We can see the gifts of the Magi as gifts for us and our journey to Jesus — gold as wisdom, frankincense as prayer and myrrh as self-denial. Let's give these gifts to Jesus that transform our hearts and then, we can transform the world.

The wise men went on a journey to Jesus, a journey from star reading to worshiping Jesus. The wise men's journey of a thousand miles which could have taken three months is really a symbol of the inward journey they made in their hearts, a journey from paganism to belief in Jesus as the Savior of the world. We each are called to allow Jesus be Lord of each part of our lives, not just when it suits us. We each have a journey to make to Jesus because none of us is yet fully converted and each of us has corners in our hearts and lives in need of Jesus' healing and redemption. We don't need a star any longer to find Christ; his light no longer dwells in the night sky but in our hearts, which, if authentic, always leads to an epiphany of understanding of God's saving love.

STAFF SPOTLIGHT: CHRISTINE IMMEL

I have always felt called to Healing Ministry. After all, it was a serious bout with illness that brought me closer to the Lord than I had ever felt in my life. I often say my greatest trial became my greatest blessing. It was what brought me back to the Catholic Church nearly 7 years ago. I joined R.C.I.A. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) in Plymouth, WI and never looked back.

My first endeavor to serve in this capacity was by forming a ministry for the sick and homebound called 'Compassionate Hearts Ministry' at St. John the Baptist Parish in Plymouth. We visited the sick, volunteered in the local nursing homes, sat vigil with the dying and prayed with the sick who were anointed at Mass. In service to those who were sick and homebound, I was giving purpose to my own suffering.

My role as R.C.I.A Coordinator at the Sheboygan South Catholic Parishes began in July of 2018. I thought the Lord was leading me to serve in an entirely new capacity. I was now a catechist and companion for new Christians and Catholics. However, I soon discovered that my new role was not far off from where I began. I have come to realize that Christianity, in its entirety, *IS* healing ministry. In fact, each person who comes to the Lord and is preparing for their Sacraments in R.C.I.A. is carrying something heavy. When we say 'YES' to the Lord's call, the Divine Physician uses *US* to heal the broken, comfort the afflicted, and guide the lost.

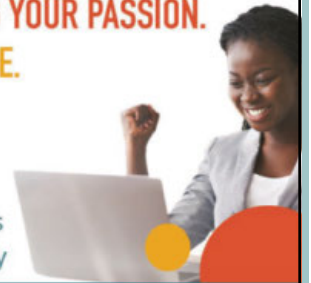
