PASTORAL MESSAGE FROM FR. SUBI THOMAS

Many of us like summer, not only because of the warm weather and sunshine, but Summer brings the most opportunity for vacation. A few days ago, one of my friends told me "when I plan our summer, family vacation, I always look for a place where I know there will be a Saturday evening or Sunday Mass."

The Sunday obligation is one of the Precepts of the Church, duties that the Catholic Church requires of all the faithful. These aren't mere guidelines, but rather a list of things that the Church teaches is necessary for Christians to do to advance in the Christian life. Our obligation is binding on every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation, no matter where we are.

The Wednesday before Thanksgiving is the busiest travel day of the year. Every year so many of us willingly endure highway traffic jams and overcrowded airports because we want to be with family members on Thanksgiving, even when we know the turkey might be overcooked, the stuffing barely edible, and the conversation boring. Why? We go because we know our presence matters to our parents, siblings, family, and friends — and we love them. We witness to this love for each other when we are present, at the table for Thanksgiving and other milestones such as birthdays, anniversaries, baptisms, First Holy Communions, weddings, and funerals. Our presence is a sign to each other of the gift and the importance of family in our lives.

"We Christians go to Sunday Mass to encounter the Risen Lord, or better still, to allow ourselves to be encountered by him, to hear His Word, to nourish ourselves at His table, and thus to become the Church." (Pope Francis)

We desire to witness to our faith and provide a living legacy to our children and grandchildren. Children are always watching their parents and grandparents. We form our young people by the way we participate in the Mass. Children who see that their parents get to Church early to pray before Mass will want to imitate them. Children who observe parents and other adults reverently receive the Eucharist will more readily realize that the Eucharist truly is the Body and Blood of Christ. Children who hear from their parents how much, and why, they love Mass will be less inclined to compare Mass to television and consider it "boring."

A great tribute at a funeral liturgy is when we describe the deceased as someone who never missed Sunday Mass and someone who had a great desire to receive the Eucharist and to be with the parish family.

Wherever you go, take your faith with you!

Staff Spotlight: Rochelle Ross

These past two years during the pandemic we have seen a lot of changes and have had to adjust our lives: weddings postponed, vacations canceled, birthday parties through the window, etc. We have also seen changes within our worship; first the churches were shut down and we could not gather for Mass. Slowly we could start gathering again, with covid restrictions. Then while remaining safe, covid restrictions were eased a bit. What we notice the most is the decrease in the number of people in Liturgical Ministries. We are very thankful to those who stepped forward as the covid restrictions eased a bit. We are also aware that some still do not feel safe and we certainly understand that.

Now is the time if you have ever thought about helping with a ministry during the mass to get involved. All three parishes have many spots open for help: from choir members to Mass servers. These ministries are normally open to people of all ages, with the exception of Communion Minister. The Church guideline for Communion Ministers is that the person must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.


