

#### PASTORAL MESSAGE FROM FR. PAUL FLISS



Happy Memorial Day weekend everyone! It is always the kick-off for summer, and this year is the first time in 3 years that our COVID transmission level is considered low. It is wonderful to celebrate and look forward to a fun summer!

As we feel the effects of high inflation and the drop in the stock market, we are all experiencing a financial crunch. Utility costs have increased substantially. This is no less true in the parishes also. We try each year to operate as parishes on the income from weekly giving, but over the last number of years, we

have had to also include income from our annual investment earnings at all our parishes. We can sustain this for only a short time. Unbudgeted repairs in older buildings, and unplanned necessary capital expenditures have a negative effect on our reserves too. In addition, the stock market has declined steadily over the past few months, reducing our total reserves by as much as 10%. This makes it hard for us to pull from our reserves to pay for our ministries, which out of need, are expanding.

Our parishes' fiscal year runs from July 1, to June 30<sup>th</sup>. The first weekend in July, we will be providing in the bulletin the discrepancy between budget and actual giving for this past year for each of the parishes. This will not include any COVID related money we received from the government. We really do depend upon your weekly or monthly, or annual giving for our parishes to provide for all our ministries. The guidelines given for most of us making less than \$100,000 family annual income is to give one fortieth of our pre-tax weekly wage, each week. This works out to about 2.5%. Those near, at, or below the poverty line should give nothing financially, but if possible volunteer time at church. Those who make more should give between 3-5%.

As we close out this fiscal year, and begin a new fiscal year, I ask you to prayerfully reflect on the graces and gifts God has given you through your faith and nurtured with the help of your parish community. And then, if possible, consider increasing your stewardship giving to your parish to help us come closer to maintaining balanced budgets.
