

## PASTORAL MESSAGE FROM FR. SUBI THOMAS



Pentecost literally means 50th. It is a feast celebrated on the 50th day after the Passover feast by the Jews and a feast celebrated on the 50th day after the feast of the Resurrection of Jesus by Christians. Today concludes the Easter season, the fifty days that, from Jesus' resurrection to Pentecost, are marked in a particular way by the presence of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit is the first gift of the risen Lord. On the day of Pentecost, the Spirit came down from heaven, in the form of "divided tongues, as of fire... [that] rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages" (Acts 2:3-4). This is how the word of God describes the working of the Spirit: first he

rests on each and then brings all of them together in fellowship. To each he gives a gift, and then gathers them all into unity.

Pope Francis says "For this to happen today, we need to avoid temptation that seeks diversity without unity. This happens when we want to separate, when we take sides and form parties, when we adopt rigid and airtight positions, when we become locked into our own ideas and ways of doing things, perhaps even thinking that we are better than others, or always in the right. When this happens, we choose the part over the whole, belonging to this or that group before belonging to the Church. We become avid supporters for one side, rather than brothers and sisters in the one Spirit. We become Christians of the "right" or the "left", before being on the side of Jesus, unbending guardians of the past or the avant-garde of the future before being humble and grateful children of the Church."

On this major feast day, we are invited to experience and appreciate the transforming, sanctifying, and strengthening presence of the Holy Spirit within us. This is also a day for us to renew our promises made to God during our Baptism and Confirmation, to profess our Faith, and to practice it.

#### STAFF SPOTLIGHT

#### From Deacon Rich Gulig:

I'd like to share with you today one of my ministries that's been very near and dear to my heart for most of my life. It's my ministry to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. My father was one of the founding members of the St. Vincent de Paul conference at Holy Name in the mid-1950s. When my mother joined in the mid-1960s then we were a home filled with the spirituality of St. Vincent de Paul. So in some respects I've been a Vincentian pretty much most of my entire life. I've served in many different capacities with the Society. First as a member of the St. Peter Claver conference, then as Spiritual Advisor to the Sheboygan district council, and finally Spiritual Advisor to the Archdiocesan Council of Milwaukee. I currently serve as the Spiritual Adviser to all of the councils and conferences within the ten county Archdiocese of Milwaukee.

This ministry, needless to say, consumes a fair amount of my deacon covenant commitment. But it's a ministry that I enjoy very much. Often times, if I'm not serving at our Tri-parish community on any given weekend, it means that I'm at another parish in the Archdiocese serving in my capacity as Spiritual Advisor for St. Vincent de Paul.

Right now is a particular exciting time for me, because the Archdiocesan Council is hosting the North Central Regional meeting of the Society in late June, in Waukesha. And I'm quite involved in the planning and the presentations for the four day conference style meeting. We anticipate several hundred attendees over four days. One highlight is the Friday afternoon Mass with Archbishop Listecki. So I ask that you keep the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in your prayers, and I thank you all for your support of this important and much needed ministry.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

#### Do You Speak Stewardship?

If you are married, I'm guessing that you know the best way to break bad news to your spouse, whether you realize it or not. Maybe it's simply that you know not to talk about the budget after your wife's football team has lost. Maybe you know your husband will take the news that your sister is coming to stay a little easier if you tell him over his favorite dinner. We do the same thing with our children, our friends, our coworkers — we have all learned the language of the people we love.

The truth is the same in every language, but it's important for us to convey that truth graciously. That's what Pentecost teaches us. The gift of being able to speak in tongues afforded the Apostles a practical skill to spread the Gospel message, but it also served as a powerful symbol of the importance of effective communication. Evangelization can only happen when you're speaking in words a person is able, ready, and willing to hear.

Let's ask ourselves: what is the language we need to speak to share the truth with the person who is standing in front of us? Is it the language of quality time? The language of concern? The language of laughter and friendship? The language of authenticity, of plain talk and frankness?

The Holy Spirit gave the Apostles the ability to speak in tongues, and it seems miraculous when we read about it in the Gospels — but only consider that we all have this same ability, in a certain way. The Holy Spirit can and will show us how to speak the truth, if we only ask.
