#### PASTORAL MESSAGE FROM FR. PAUL FLISS



In a previous bulletin article, I wrote about the development in staffing over the past few years in our Sheboygan South Catholic Parishes. The majority of our staff members are employed by all three parishes. The only exceptions: each parish funds their own maintenance and liturgical staff. Today I want to help us remember the new ministries we have developed over the past few years.

In pastoral care, we have developed a comprehensive communion ministry for the homebound, and those in nursing homes. Our aim with the help of lay ministers, is to give the Eucharist to those who

wish to receive it either weekly or monthly. The priests also try to visit each homebound person at least twice a year. This has been frustrated by COVID, but we look to return to our practice soon. We now celebrate the sacrament of the sick monthly during a weekend Mass at one of our parishes. It is so important for the whole community to be present as we lift-up in prayer and sacrament those who are struggling with serious illness. Fr Subi and I meet regularly with those in hospice, as often as they wish as they prepare to make their final journey to the Lord. One of our most appreciated new ministries is our Birthday card ministry, for those who are homebound or in nursing homes. Finally, we have created some Masses and services involving all three parishes, including, Thanksgiving, and Holy Saturday, and the Stations of the Cross, and the annual Pet Blessing, and Children's Liturgy of the Word during Mass, Hmong Catholic New Year Celebration, and a Hmong Catholic summer picnic and Mass. Fr Subi and I, along with our Liturgy staff, and Spiritual Life and Worship commission are working to offer greater diversity in worship styles, to help us all become accustomed to the varieties offered within the tradition of the Church. In my next bulletin article I will continue to look at our newer ministries in the other areas of parish life.

#### STAFF SPOTLIGHT

#### From Deacon John Gavin

Every week, Archbishop Listecki reminds us of our basic Christian Duty to "Love One Another". Jesus even extends this command to loving our enemy. This is challenging, especially when we think about political issues. In these situations it is helpful, I think, to reflect on the essential foundations of Catholic Social Teaching. The Church offers four principles in this regard\*:

The dignity of the human person. All human life is sacred and deserves respect. While our opposition to abortion flows from this principle, so does our love and care for the woman and man involved in any unplanned pregnancy. This principle also informs our care for the poor, the vulnerable and the aged. This principle leads us to oppose racism, torture, human trafficking, and the death penalty. It also calls us to respect and listen to differing opinions.

Subsidiarity. Human life is not only sacred but also social. The family is the basic building block of a society. This principle leads Catholics to support families in their basic role to raise a family, and choices in education for their children. Decisions should be made at the lowest or smallest group affected by the decision. Larger organizations and governments should not interfere with these responsibilities unless the smaller or more local group cannot meet the needs of those involved.

The common good: This principle leads us to defend our basic rights, freedom of speech, conscience protections, and religious freedom. This leads us to support the dignity of work and protection of worker rights. It also leads us to care for God's Creation.

#### STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

#### Up to the Job

Have you ever had a job for which you didn't feel qualified? I think we all have, whether it was a paying gig or not. A lot of us parents often feel in awe of the magnitude of that role and lose sleep worrying that we made the wrong decision in one situation or a bad call in another. Some of us feel intimidated by what our communities need from us, on the parish level or in our personal relationships. Or maybe we are simply dreading a task that seems too big, too overwhelming — that necessary basement cleanout, or the weekly organization of family schedules.

When we don't feel qualified, we don't want to do the work. We get stuck in our own fear. That's the birthplace of procrastination, self-doubt and bitterness. When we look inward at our own abilities, we can only see all the traits that aren't there. The intelligence, the dexterity, the ambition — whatever it is we lack, we get stuck on it. I've got good news and bad news. I'll start with the bad news: none of us are qualified for the call of discipleship. We simply aren't. We don't have the love or grace or strength to get the job done. Now I'll give you the good news: God knows this, and He doesn't care. Stewardship does not insist that we possess every good quality — no, as a way of life, stewardship recognizes that we lack so many qualities. But it shows us where to find the love and grace and strength we need. Stewardship does not demand that we know every answer; it merely reminds us who to ask when we don't.


