

PASTORAL MESSAGE FROM FR. SUBI THOMAS

I am so happy to share a wonderful experience that touched my heart. A couple of weeks ago, on a Saturday afternoon at St. Peter Claver, I was scheduled to administer the sacrament of baptism for a baby. I was in the church by the baptismal font a few minutes before the baptism, making sure everything was ready, waiting to begin. The family was in the gathering space. It was then that I noticed a three-year-old boy, the older brother of the baby to be baptized, taking his family members two-by-two inside the church, pointing to the crucifix, and telling them, "Look, that's Jesus, He loves you." *I felt so proud of his parents*.

There is just one thing I would like to remind the parents and grandparents who are so dear to their children, something that you already know. "The transmission of the Faith can only be done in "dialect," in the "language" of the family, the "dialect" or "language" used by the father and mother, the grandfather and grandmother". (Pope Francis) The priests and teachers will come later and develop this first transmission of the Faith, with ideas and explanations.

But do not forget this: if the "dialect" is missing, if at home you do not speak the language of love and faith as parents, the transmission of the Faith is not so easy; it cannot be done. Do not forget this. Your task is to transmit the Faith, but you must do it with the language of love of your home, the language of family. Faith is passed on when parents live out an authentic, faithful life to God, leading their kids by example. Transmitting faith to growing children is not the job of the church; rather, the church's role is to come alongside families to help them develop strong faith and values that will guide their children so that they too can pass their faith along to the next generation.

I learned this "dialect", not from my 12 years of seminary training, but from my wonderful parents. The inheritance you *leave to* your children will not last forever. But the inheritance (faith and values) you *leave in* them will never run out.

Ss. Cyril & Methodius Finance Council

The Ss. Cyril & Methodius Finance Council continues to meet regularly to ensure that our Church's finances are properly managed. We review monthly financial reports, discuss investments with our financial advisers, create a yearly budget, and work closely with our Buildings and Grounds Committee to provide the finances needed for keeping our facilities in good working condition.

Every year brings its financial challenges. On the income side, this past year's financial contributions were down from the previous year. Interest income from our Trust remains lower because of the low interest rate environment. Donations were up but bequests were down.

Raffle income helped offset income that our festival used to bring in. It was the governments Employee Retention Credit and Paycheck Protection Programs that helped reduce our deficit. Total expenses came in over budget with several extraordinary expenses including the new stairway going down to the lower parking lot, the repair of broken sidewalks in the front of church, and repairs to the school roof.

Thank you for your continued support to our Church. Also, we continue to need a second member for the Tri-Parish Council. Please consider being a representative of our Church for this important group.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

What We Store in the Barn

I once knew a godly woman who had truly tasted the bitterness of this earthly life. This woman knew pain. She knew sacrifice. She knew hard labor and loss, including the death of a cherished child. She worked each day at a low-paying job, waiting patiently for her 65th birthday, when she could retire and devote herself full-time to her grandchildren. She crossed off the dwindling days on her calendar like a first grader waiting for Christmas.

Ninety-eight days before she was set to retire, she died suddenly. Her name was erased from the schedule at work and penciled over with that of her replacement hire.

All things are vanity.

I think we all know someone like this, don't we? If the details aren't exactly the same, the outline of the story is: someone labors "with wisdom and knowledge and skill," in the words of Ecclesiastes. And what profit comes to him? Sorrow and grief all his days. The proverbial barn filled with harvest and left to rot.

But I'll let you in on a secret: this isn't a sad story. I've only told you part of it.

This woman heard, daily, the voice of God, and against it she never hardened her heart, whatever news it brought her. This woman loved as hard as she worked. Every action was a form of evangelization. To talk to her was to feel the embrace of Christ.

As much as she waited for that retirement that never came, it was never the harvest in her barn.

This is what it means to be a true steward: to seek what is above.


