The Sheboygan South Catholic Parish Food Pantry is run like a well-oiled machine - because of volunteers -28 of them!

Each food pantry day, the first volunteers arrive at SPC Van Treek Hall at 7:45 a.m. to move chairs and put tables in order. Then the rest of the volunteers start coming in to arrange their tables with the particular food items that they give out. At 8:55 everyone is called together for announcements and prayer. Then the doors swing wide at 9:00!

Volunteers spring into action, each performing different duties. Some are experienced in registering those new to the Pantry. Many man the tables, helping customers to peruse the food and make their choices. Some can be counted on to restock the tables as food runs low. Everyone supplies enjoyable conversation and good-natured jokes. A few are able and ready to lend a hand to load groceries into vehicles. At 10:30, the doors, and everyone helps to store remaining food and put tables and chairs back into place.

Christ Child Academy middle schoolers come to help once a month. They also arrange food and help customers to make their food choices. They and our customers hit it off, enjoying each other's company. Quite a learning experience for the kids!

In between pantry days, other tasks are accomplished. Two husband and wife teams alternate going to Festival Foods on Fridays to pick up day-old bread, rolls and bakery and store these into our freezer. This is a big project! One volunteer routinely comes into the pantry to sort food and stack it in grocery carts, ready for each volunteer's table. This is an undertaking that requires an experienced understanding of the flow of incoming and outgoing food, and the space available on shelves and in freezers. A "shopping list" of foods is kept, and one volunteer orders what is needed from Festival Foods, while another orders from the Sheboygan County Food Bank. Since the pandemic, this can be a tricky duty, because of supply chain issues. Tom Halbach picks up from Festival Foods, taking another volunteer when the amount of food is large. He also picks up milk each day that the Pantry is open. Statistics must be recorded and reported and meetings within the wider community attended. Writing thank you notes to donors is a constant.

All of our volunteers are dedicated to our customers and to their duties. Many have volunteered for years and I can't possibly say enough about them. We are not just a team, but a family. And readers - you are also our loyal volunteers, because of all of your food and monetary donations. We couldn't do it without you,

# EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

#### Caught in the Rising Action

Think of some of your favorite iconic movies. I'm not talking about the feel-good comedies or the offbeat comingof-age flicks. I'm talking about the movies that you found had a profound impact on you or made you go "Hmmm." I'm willing to bet that the plot of this film features some tough moments and difficult scenarios. However happy the ending, at some point, the situation for the protagonist might look awfully hopeless. The script speaks some truth to you about what it is to be human in difficult circumstances. What it means to persevere.

We're attracted to the tension that exists when the hero is besieged. We're captivated by the decisions he makes in the darkest hour of the night when it seems like the dawn will never come. Why? Because we know that feeling so well. This is the essence of our human life on earth: waiting, hoping, doubting — and enduring.

We know the ending to our story, but we don't know when it's coming. We live our whole lives in the rising action of the narrative. Sure, it gets old. Tiresome, even dull. We may start to despair that the climactic scene is coming at all.But faith is the realization of things hoped for, and evidence of things not seen. We feel it watching a great movie, because we recognize it intuitively: it is faith which earns the happy ending. No one is drawn to the story when the hero gives up or gets tired of waiting for the payoff. Everyday stewardship is the collection of choices we make while we're waiting, because we are called to action, not idleness, even in our perpetual state of expectation.
