My Dear Family;

As St. Paul pointed out, we all are connected through the earthly Adam through whom paradise was lost, and through the heavenly Adam, Jesus Christ, through whom paradise was regained. While we too often fall back on our earthly inclinations of judging others, maintaining resentments, closing ourselves to people who look, think or act differently than we do, Jesus calls us to a higher life. He challenges us to follow his example of love, without exception, without judgment, without limits. He challenges us to respect, to include, to feel and express compassion for every person God created. We are family and love is the family trait inborn in us through our heavenly Father.

It has been said that if you knew everything there was to know about a person, you could forgive them anything. Let’s keep that in mind the next time we are tempted to make a judgment or to shun someone for who we think they are. Let’s remember our family motto, “Love one another as I have loved you.” May our family resemblance grow so we can inspire others to a life of love.

Readings for Sunday, February 20, 2022 — Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23; Psalm 103: 1-4, 8, 10, 12-13; 1 Corinthians 15: 45-49; Luke 6: 27-38

Reflection Questions:

- David was in the perfect position to kill Saul, but he did not. When were times in your own life when you felt you were tempted to do something wrong but something held you back? What were some of the things that held you back in the end?
- In the first letter to the Corinthians, it talks about how the first man was earthly and the second man is heavenly. People start off earthly and eventually become heavenly. What do you think we can do to help the process of becoming heavenly?
- Jesus tells us to be kind to everyone, especially those who are our enemies and mistreat us. No matter what they do, we should never try to retaliate. How have you tried to be kind to someone even after they treated you badly? Does it come naturally to you or does it take effort to try to behave this way?

No importa lo que hagan, nunca debemos intentar tomar represalias. ¿Cómo has tratado de ser bueno con alguien incluso después de que te hayan tratado mal? ¿Te resulta natural o te cuesta esfuerzo tratar de comportarte de esta manera?*
