My Dear Family;

The Gospel this weekend is a wake-up call, as we find ourselves on the third of six Sundays that culminate in Palm Sunday. The beginning of the reading is a startling alarm, a call to repent. But, lest we lose heart, Jesus shares a parable of hope and challenge. Yes, we are at the halfway point of these important six weeks in our spiritual journey, but it is not too late! Now is the time to assess our growth during the first weeks of Lent. Have we been faithful to our plans to sacrifice in ways that make a difference in someone's life? Have we made time to spend with Jesus as he journeys toward Jerusalem on Palm Sunday? Have we offered forgiveness where it is needed and asked for forgiveness where we need to? Have we set aside time daily for prayer? Have we acted on our intentions for sharing our bounty with the less fortunate? In other words, have we born fruit?

Today's Gospel points out that we always have another opportunity to change our lives, to grow spiritually, to bear fruit. Like the gardener in this parable, we simply need to ask for an extension, another chance to put dedicated effort into our lives; to prune away those things that keep us from growing and being fruitful; and to nurture the goodness within us, so that it may flourish and fill us with the fruit of a loving and compassionate life. It isn't too late, but it is time...time to begin afresh.

El Evangelio de este fin de semana es una llamada de atención al encontrarnos en el tercero de los seis domingos que culminan con el Domingo de Ramos. El comienzo de la lectura es un llamado alarmante, un llamado al arrepentimiento. Pero, para que no nos desanimemos, Jesús comparte una parábola de esperanza y desafío. Ya estamos a la mitad de estas importantes seis semanas en nuestro viaje espiritual, ¡pero no es demasiado tarde! Ahora es el momento de evaluar nuestro crecimiento durante las primeras semanas de Cuaresma. ¿Hemos sido fieles a nuestros planes de sacrificarnos de maneras que hagan una diferencia en la vida de alguien? ¿Hemos dedicado tiempo para estar con Jesús mientras viaja hacia Jerusalén el Domingo de Ramos? ¿Hemos ofrecido perdón donde se necesita y pedido perdón cuando fue necesario? ¿Hemos reservado tiempo diariamente para la oración? ¿Hemos actuado de acuerdo con nuestras intenciones de compartir nuestra generosidad con los menos afortunados? En otras palabras, ¿hemos dado fruto?

El evangelio de hoy señala que siempre tenemos otra oportunidad de cambiar de vida, de crecer espiritualmente, de dar fruto. Como el jardinero en esta parábola, simplemente necesitamos pedir más tiempo, otra oportunidad para hacer un esfuerzo dedicado a nuestras vidas; para podar aquellas cosas que nos impiden crecer y dar frutos; y para alimentar la bondad dentro de nosotros, para que pueda florecer y llenarnos con el fruto de una vida amorosa y compasiva. No es demasiado tarde, pero ya es tiempo... tiempo de empezar de nuevo.

Encountering God in the Natural World

Readings for Sunday, March 20, 2022 — Third Sunday of Lent

Exodus 3:1-8A, 13-15; Psalm 103:1-2, 3-4, 6-7, 8, 11; 1 Corinthians 10:1-6, 10-12; Luke 13:1-9

Reflection Questions:

- Moses tends the flock of his father-in-law. The life of a shepherd is one of silent watchfulness. Amidst the desert at the base of Mount Horeb, Moses observes a bush blazing with fire, yet it is not consumed by the flames. Moses' curiosity compels him to investigate this phenomenon and eventually leads Moses to an encounter with God that forever changes his life and the lives, story, and tradition of an entire people. Has your sense of curiosity about the natural world ever yielded an opportunity to experience the presence of God? How can you incorporate Moses' quiet watchfulness into your own busy life?
- The psalmist describes God's kindness as mysterious and limitless, just like the heavens. Learn something new about our universe this week. Can you see God's infinite goodness and kindness reflected in the vastness of space? How?
- In Luke's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the fig tree. The orchard owner, frustrated that the tree has yet to bear fruit, instructs the gardener to chop it down. The gardener suggests that perhaps the tree requires some extra care, nurture, and cultivation to be fruitful. Is there a relationship with a friend, colleague, family member, or significant other you have been tempted to end because it does not seem to be fruitful? How can you, like the gardener, give it the care it deserves to see if some cultivation can help it flourish? When do you know it is time to cut a relationship that is not being fruitful?

Éxodo 3:1-8A, 13-15; Salmo 103:1-2, 3-4, 6-7, 8, 11; 1 Corintios 10:1-6, 10-12; Lucas 13:1-9

Preguntas de reflexión:

- *Moisés cuida el rebaño de su suegro. La vida de un pastor es una de vigilancia en silencio. En medio del desierto, al pie del monte Horeb, Moisés observa una zarza que arde, pero que no es consumida por las llamas. La curiosidad de Moisés lo impulsa a investigar este fenómeno y finalmente lo lleva a un encuentro con Dios que cambia para siempre su propia vida y la vida, la historia y la tradición de todo un pueblo. ¿Tu sentido de curiosidad por el mundo natural te ha brindado alguna vez la oportunidad de experimentar la presencia de Dios? ¿Cómo puedes incorporar la vigilancia en silencio de Moisés en tu ya tan ocupada vida?*
- *El salmista describe la bondad de Dios como misteriosa e ilimitada, como los cielos. Aprende algo nuevo sobre nuestro universo esta semana. ¿Puedes ver la bondad infinita de Dios reflejada en la inmensidad del espacio? ¿Cómo?*
- *En el Evangelio de Lucas, Jesús cuenta la parábola de la higuera. El dueño del huerto, frustrado porque el árbol aún no ha dado frutos, le indica al jardinero que lo corte. El jardinero sugiere que tal vez el árbol requiera un poco más de cuidado, nutrición y cultivo para que dé fruto. ¿Ha habido una relación con un amigo, colega, familiar o pareja que ha estado a punto de terminar porque no parece que dé frutos? ¿Cómo puedes, como el jardinero, darle el cuidado que merece para ver si algún cultivo puede ayudarla a florecer? ¿Cuándo sabes que es hora de cortar una relación que no está dando fruto?*
