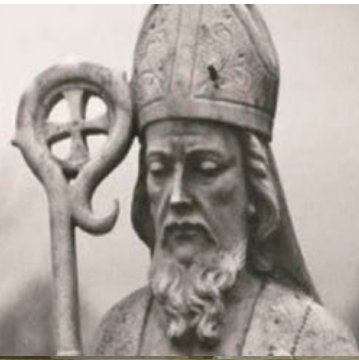

## Encountering God during Holy Week

Readings for Sunday, April 10, 2022 – Palm Sunday of the Lord’s Passion Luke 19:28-40; Isaiah 50:4-7; Psalm 22:8-9, 17-18, 19-20, 23-24; Philippians 2:8-9; Luke 22:14-23:56 or Luke 23:1-49

### Reflection Questions:

- Luke’s Gospel discusses the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. Just a few short days before his arrest, trial, and death — all riddled with pain and humiliation — Jesus is welcomed as a king. When told by the Pharisees to silence the joyful cries of his disciples, Jesus tells them that if they remain silent, the very stones will cry out. Palm Sunday is both a day of joyful proclamation of Jesus as the Messiah and a day of sorrow at the thought of what he has come to Jerusalem to accomplish — death on the cross for the salvation of all. This week, do not be silent. If others are silent, be like the stones on the road to Jerusalem; cry out! Who needs you to cry out with joy this week? Who is in the midst of sorrow and injustice and needs your voice? What can you do to make sure your cry will be heard and acted upon?
- On Palm Sunday, we pray with the psalmist the words that Jesus cries out from the cross: “My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?” Perhaps Jesus prays these words to remind us that even when we feel forsaken by God, God is always present. Have you ever felt abandoned by God? What does Jesus’ Passion reveal to us about God’s presence during our suffering?
- Today we will hear a proclamation of the entire Passion Narrative from Luke’s Gospel. Before attending Mass, make an effort to read it in its entirety. If you can, print the text from the USCCB website and use a pen to underline words, phrases, and sentences that stand out to you. Go back and read what you underlined. What spoke to you this year? Did you read something you never took notice of before? Why did it stick out to you now? Did something that happened in your life this year impact the way you read it?



## Encontrándonos con Dios en la Semana Santa

Lucas 19:28-40; Isaías 50:4-7; Salmo 22:8-9, 17-18, 19-20, 23-24; Filipenses 2:8-9; Lucas 22:14-23:56 o Lucas 23:1-49

### Preguntas de reflexión:

- El Evangelio de Lucas habla de la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén. Solo unos pocos días antes de su arresto, juicio y muerte, todo lleno de dolor y humillación, Jesús es recibido como rey. Cuando los fariseos les dijeron que callara los gritos de alegría de sus discípulos, Jesús les dijo que si permanecían en silencio, las mismas piedras gritarían. El Domingo de Ramos es tanto un día de jubilosa proclamación de Jesús como el Mesías como un día de tristeza al pensar en lo que ha venido a cumplir a Jerusalén: la muerte en la cruz para la salvación de todos. Esta semana, no te quedes callado. Si los demás callan, se como las piedras en el camino de Jerusalén; ¡grita! ¿Quién necesita que llores de alegría esta semana? ¿Quién está en medio del dolor y la injusticia y necesita tu voz? ¿Qué puedes hacer para asegurarte de que tu clamor sea escuchado y se actúe por eso?
- El Domingo de Ramos, rezamos con el salmista las palabras que Jesús clama desde la cruz: “Dios mío, Dios mío, ¿por qué me has abandonado?” Quizás Jesús reza estas palabras para recordarnos que incluso cuando nos sentimos abandonados por Dios, Dios siempre está presente. ¿Alguna vez te has sentido abandonado por Dios? ¿Qué nos revela la Pasión de Jesús sobre la presencia de Dios durante nuestro sufrimiento?
- Hoy escucharemos una proclamación de toda la Narrativa de la Pasión del Evangelio de Lucas. Antes de asistir a Misa, haga el esfuerzo de leerla en su totalidad. Si puede, imprima el texto del sitio web de la USCCB y use un bolígrafo para subrayar las palabras, frases y oraciones que le llamen la atención. Vuelve atrás y lee lo que subrayaste. ¿Qué te habló este año? ¿Leíste algo que nunca habías notado antes? ¿Por qué te llamó la atención ahora? ¿Algo que sucedió en tu vida este año impactó la forma en que lo lees?

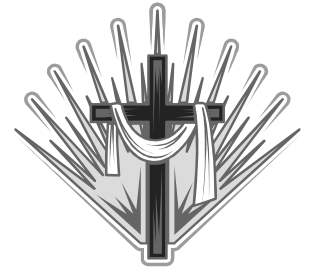

**Celebrate with Bells**

Historically bells have been rung during the Gloria at Mass on Holy Thursday and then the Mass took a more solemn tone as the Triduum (from the Latin meaning *three days*) began. Bells were not rung again until the singing of the Gloria at the Great Easter Vigil thus signifying a celebration of the end of the Lenten fast. **We invite you to bring bells of any kind to ring during the Gloria on Holy Thursday (April 14<sup>th</sup>), the Easter Vigil (April 16<sup>th</sup>) and for all Masses on Easter Sunday (April 17<sup>th</sup>).**



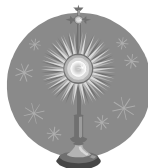
**Celebrando con Campanas**
