Hello everyone,

Hope everyone is doing well and enjoying our cool springtime.

Sheep are mentioned many times in the Bible, perhaps more than any other animal. People relied on the sheep for their livelihood. Sheep provided wool, meat, and milk; they were also a symbol of God's people.

Some of the characteristics of sheep are: domesticated sheep don't do well alone; they like to be in flocks. They are very susceptible to predators; therefore they are always in need of a shepherd. They learn to recognize the voice of the shepherd and trust him.

Jesus called himself the Good Shepherd. In today's Gospel, he says, "My sheep hear my voice, I know them and they follow me". Jesus, after his resurrection, appeared to his disciples and tells Peter to look after his sheep. We are now the followers of Jesus, we are his church, and we are his sheep. To hear Jesus' voice means more than just hearing. We need to trust in him and let ourselves be led by him through his shepherds, especially in these times when there is so much confusion.

Most of us have very busy lives now. Do you feel that you have to hear and follow Jesus to have eternal life? How do we listen to Jesus' voice in our daily lives? Do you feel that in a way we ourselves are all shepherds for others?

## **My Sheep Hear My Voice**

Readings for Sunday, May 8, 2022 — Fourth Sunday of Easter

Acts 13:14, 43-52; Psalm 100:1-3, 5; Revelation 7:9, 14B-17; John 10:27-30

### **Reflection Questions:**

- The psalmist proclaims that God made us, and we belong to God. God tends us like a shepherd tends a flock. Most of us are relatively removed from the realities of raising livestock. What does it mean to you to be part of the “flock of God”? What do sheep mean to their shepherd? Can you think of another modern analogy that might express this relationship? How do you see God tending to us like a shepherd tends to his flock?
- John has a vision that shows people of every race and culture adorned in white at the throne of the Lamb (Jesus). Jesus is the shepherd who guards them, attends to their every need, and comforts them. The sheep of Jesus are all different, yet they belong to one flock, just like the Church. What gifts do people of different cultures and backgrounds bring to the flock of your parish community? In these days, how can we show others the goodness diversity brings to our community and nation?
- In this week’s Gospel reading, Jesus assures us that if we follow him and listen to his voice he will give us eternal life. No one can take us from him. What does it mean to belong to God? Why do sheep follow their shepherd? Why do we follow Jesus? How do you hear Jesus’ voice in your everyday life?



## **Mis Ovejas Escuchan Mi Voz**

### **Preguntas de reflexión:**

- *El salmista proclama que Dios nos hizo y que pertenecemos a Dios. Dios nos atiende como un pastor a un rebaño. La mayoría de nosotros estamos relativamente alejados de las realidades de la crianza de ganado. ¿Qué significa para ti ser parte del “rebaño de Dios”? ¿Qué significan las ovejas para su pastor? ¿Puedes pensar en otra analogía moderna que pueda expresar esta relación? ¿Cómo ves a Dios atendiéndonos como un pastor atiende a su rebaño?*
- *Juan tiene una visión que muestra a personas de todas las razas y culturas vestidas de blanco ante el trono del Cordero (Jesús). Jesús es el pastor que los cuida, atiende a todas sus necesidades y los consuela. Las ovejas de Jesús son todas diferentes, pero pertenecen a un solo rebaño, al igual que la Iglesia. ¿Qué dones aportan las personas de diferentes culturas y orígenes al rebaño de su comunidad parroquial? En estos días, ¿cómo podemos mostrar a los demás la bondad que la diversidad trae a nuestra comunidad y nación?*
- *En la lectura del Evangelio de esta semana, Jesús nos asegura que si lo seguimos y escuchamos su voz, nos dará la vida eterna. Nadie nos puede apartar de él. ¿Qué significa pertenecer a Dios? ¿Por qué las ovejas siguen a su pastor? ¿Por qué seguimos a Jesús? ¿Cómo escuchas la voz de Jesús en tu vida diaria?*

This universal synod begins with a period of diocesan consultation. Over the next few months, we will be engaging people of all backgrounds and life circumstances in a process of listening and dialogue.

The 2021-2023 Synod focuses on three themes: communion, participation and mission. The foundational questions of the Synod are: “How is this ‘journeying together’ happening today in your particular Church? What steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our “journeying together?”
