

A Message from Marc

Many of you have probably prayed to St. Anthony when you've lost your keys or some other small object and rejoiced when he somehow helped jog your memory and you found the missing item in the literal last place you looked. While St. Anthony of Padua (awesome preacher from the 1300s), 'Finder of Lost Stuff' is pretty great, there is another, more ancient St. Anthony, that has much to teach us in the way of discipleship and sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ with others. The original St. Anthony, AKA St. Anthony the Great, lived in Egypt in



the 3rd and 4th centuries and we celebrate his feast day on January 17th. He is considered one of the 'Desert Fathers' as he spent most of his life in solitude in the desert of Egypt, seeking to be united with God through prayer and fasting. His single-hearted devotion to the Lord filled him with a great wisdom that many people sought out and he generously guided many others in the way of deepening closeness with the Lord Jesus.



One key lesson St. Anthony the Great can give us today is the importance of prayer in our daily lives. While God is probably not calling most of us to live completely alone in a mountain in the middle of the desert, He is calling each of us to a life of intimate friendship with Himself, even in the midst of our lives in our families, communities, and workplaces. I know hardly any of us can pray for hours every day but I'm sure we could all set aside 15 minutes a day - that's 1% of 24 hours! - to spend some time with Jesus in prayer. My encouragement to you this week to is to ask the Lord Jesus what a good time of day is for you to carve out some quiet time with Him. Perhaps it's the morning, perhaps it's before bed, or maybe sometime in the middle of the day is best for you. The important thing is to put it in your calendar - every day - and

keep that appointment with Him. It is also helpful if you find a regular place in which to spend that time in prayer. While praying in the presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is wonderful, it's not always easy to get to the church every day. Perhaps there is a chair in your home that would work well, or maybe you can even set up a prayer table with a crucifix, icon of Jesus or Mary, and candle to help you focus your mind and senses on being with Jesus during your prayer time. Once you have your time and place for prayer, my encouragement for what to do during that time would be to read a passage from the Gospels and meditate on it for a while. You can't go wrong with the Gospel reading for the day's Mass as a source of inspiration!

One other lesson St. Anthony the Great has for us is that we don't need to be brilliant, dynamic speakers, or 'in-your-face' with people to share the Gospel with them. Anthony's closeness with Jesus Christ produced a peace, joy, and aura of grace within him that people were attracted to. As people sought him out to learn more about his way of life he was able to share with them the secret behind it all - daily companionship with the Love that created the universe and became human in Jesus Christ. May the love of Jesus Christ pour out from us as we draw ever closer to Him in daily prayer! St. Anthony the Great, pray for us!


