A Message from Fr. Scott

Dear friends in Christ,

Over the past few weeks I have written about Pat Lencioni's video on "transition management" (you can watch the full video here: https://vimeo.com/171578804).

Last week I shared Pat's insight that we need to "ceremonialize" the losses and endings that we experience during a transition – regardless of whether we believe the transition to be positive or negative – because this helps us to commit to the new/to the road ahead and to not get stuck.

As an illustration, he shares the famous story of Cortés arriving to Mexico in 1519 with 600 tired soldiers who didn't want to go on. To motivate the men Cortés burned their ships, in effect saying to them: "there is no going back; we're in this together and for the long haul!"

Once we have identified our losses, chosen our response, and ceremonialized any ending(s), we then move into what Pat calls the "neutral zone." This is where the old thing is gone but the new thing hasn't arrived yet or doesn't quite feel right. Think "wandering in the desert" – like the Hebrews we've left Egypt, but the Promised Land still seems far away.

In order to navigate this challenging stage of a transition well, we need 2 C's and 4 P's. First, we need extra care and concern. With respect to Into the Deep, to the extent that the other priests and I (and our parish staff members) can provide this for you we will try our best to do so. But, even beyond our humble and imperfect efforts, please remember that God Himself cares for each of us – for you! – and has great concern for your (eternal) good (i.e., your salvation)! As such, let us take to heart anew the words of St. Peter during this difficult time of transition: "Cast all your worries upon him because he cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7).

In addition to these 2 C's, Pat also says that we need 4 P's while making our way through the neutral zone. The 4 P's are:

- 1) Purpose why are we doing this?
- 2) Picture what are we hoping the outcome will look like?
- 3) Plan how will we get there?
- 4) Part what role do you and I have to play?

Next week I'll address the first of these 4 P's – the purpose of Into the Deep. But for now, I leave you with these inspiring words from St. Ignatius of Loyola: "God's love calls us to move beyond fear. We ask God for the courage to abandon ourselves unreservedly, so that we might be molded by God's grace, even as we cannot see where that path may lead us."
