

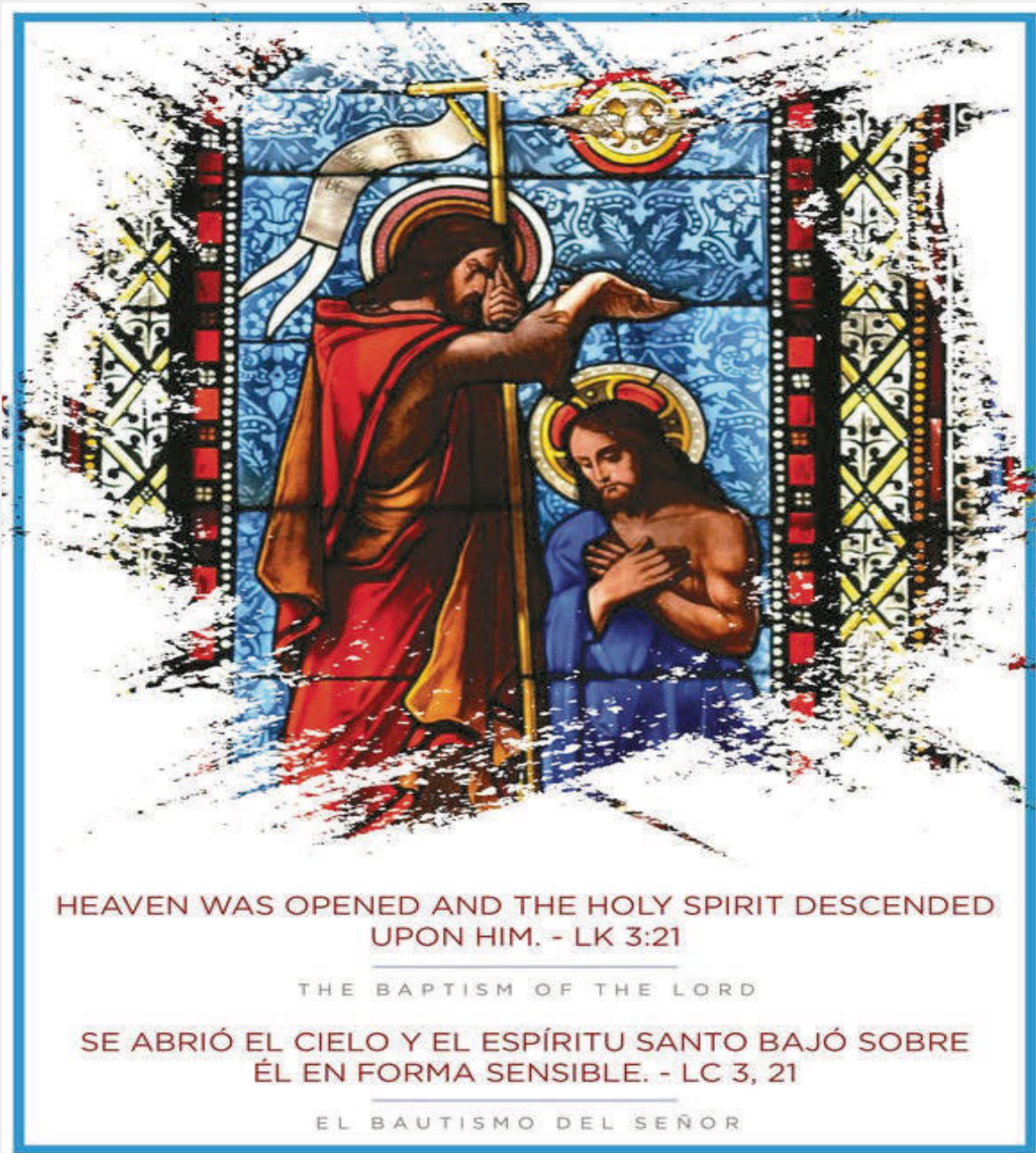

Or: Acts 10:34-38

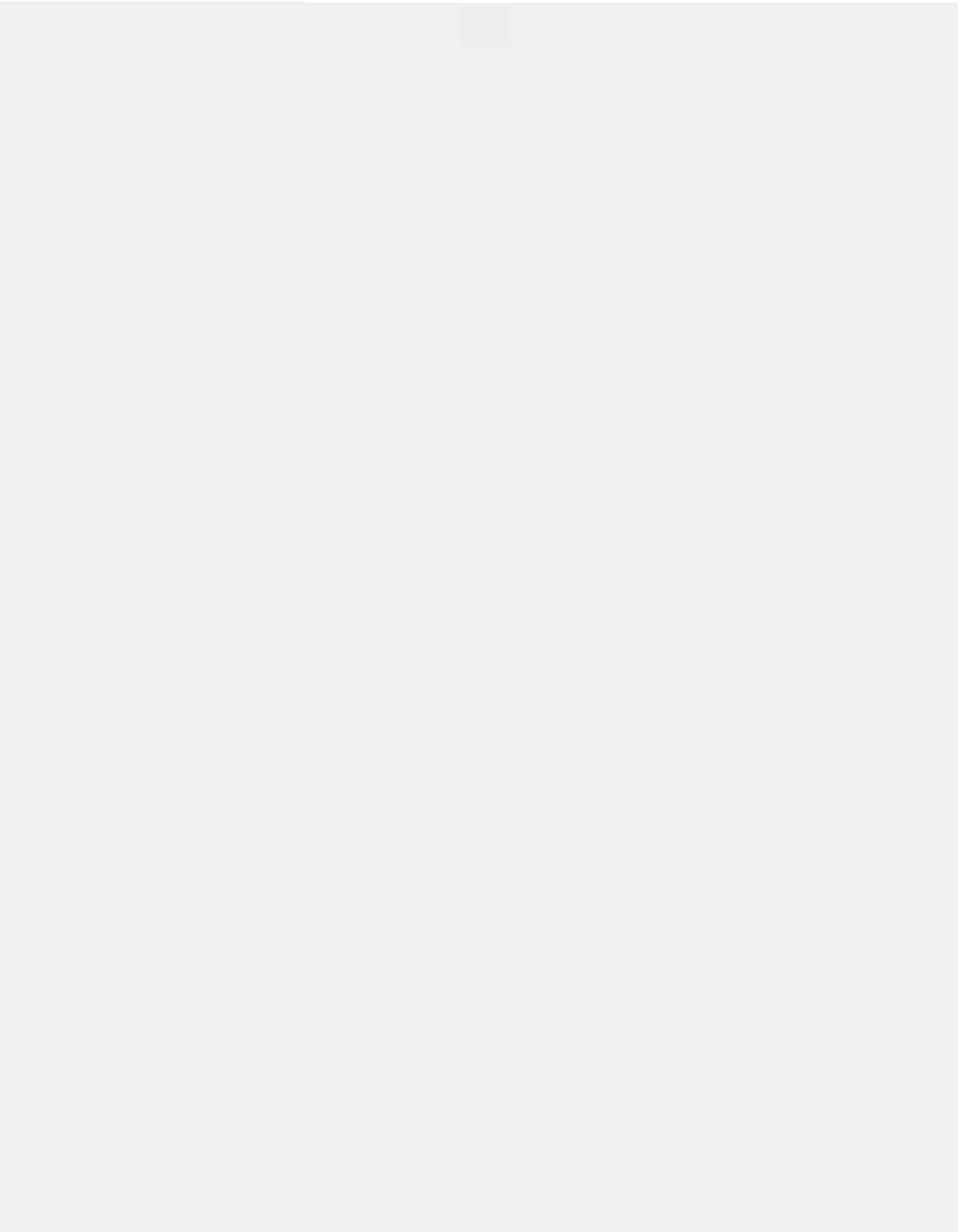
