Pastor's Corner by Fr. Joe Noonan

Merry Christmas! “This is the day the Lord has made let us rejoice and be glad in it” (Psalm 118:24). The experience of Christmas is unique to each person. For some, the holiday is a short break from work or school. For others, it is a festive and busy time of hosting or visiting family and friends. Some see it as an opportunity to share gifts or to serve others in need. Overlying these Christmas activities is the remembrance of the day in which “God so loved the world that he sent his only Son”. It is a love so profound that God took on our human nature and entered his creation in the person of Jesus Christ. In the human nature of Jesus, God walked as we walk, talked as we talk and died as we will one day. In the divine nature of Jesus, God conquered sin and death through Jesus’ Passion, Death and Resurrection.

Nothing can separate us from God. The Holy Spirit continues to work among us, especially in the Sacraments, to invite us to a deeper relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

Merry Christmas. Jesus said, “I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete” (John 15:11). Experience the joy of Jesus with us here at St. Damian. 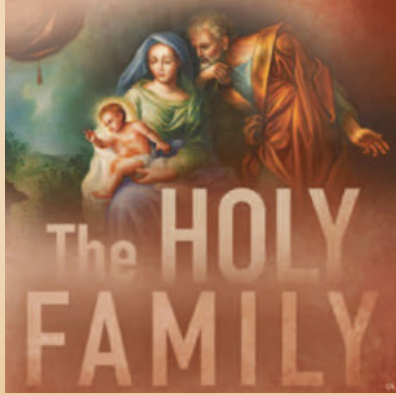

Mark does not like any attention; instead he would like to thank everyone who helped support the ministry in some way, either financially or helping him physically hang signs in all types of winter weather. Christ on Central expands from Midlothian Turnpike to 176th Street giving all the glory, thanks, and praise to God.

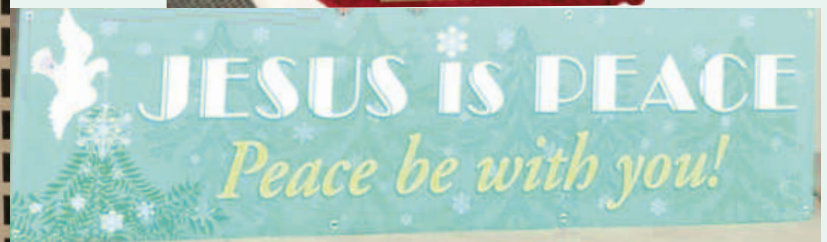

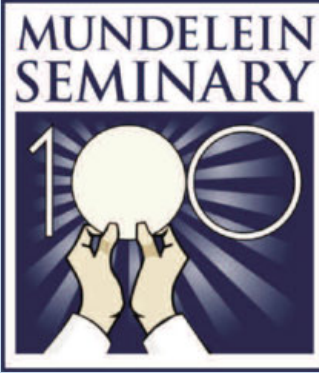
