Rose, Mary & Tim - Mothers' Day; No greater love than this!



This photo on the Internet, *gripped me* this week! A vivid, perhaps uncomfortable reminder of the intense love, which our Mothers have shown toward us all: *despite great pain, they gave us birth.* '10 centimeters dilation' – they endured labor and pain, so that we could leave the womb and enter the world. *Only one who's given birth can really know this unique & essential love.*

"Love in action is a harsh and dreadful thing, compared to love in dreams", Dostoevsky wrote. Indeed!

As a twin, whose delivery was almost fatal for our Mom, *Germaine*, I think of how deep that love, even before our Moms knew us, or how we would respond to their *'laying down their lives'* for us! How humbling that is! *They took a painful risk on*



us! Hopefully we haven't caused them to regret it! **he Blessed Virgin Mary** took that risk in bringing Jesus into the world, under the most primitive and unwelcoming conditions – in a stable!

Not only for Jesus (as if He weren't enough) but also out of love for the whole human family, she became "Mother of God", and "Mother of us all, in the Church"!

Today's Gospel passage comes from around the Last Supper table:



"Love one another as I have loved you.
There can be no greater love than this:
to lay down one's life for one's friend." (John 15:12, 13.)

We could easily let ourselves 'off the hook' by saying:

"That's only for Early Christians, thrown to the lions; that's only for Martyrs, Christian heroes. That's only for those who died in battle, or in some dramatic, adrenaline-charged moment in which they sacrificed everything. That's not for me."

But it is - for 'ordinary people', like you & me: spouses, siblings, singles. Jesus' teaching is fulfilled whenever we give ourselves away; whenever we put another before ourselves. Then, we 'lay down our lives' for another. "White Martyrdom", the Early Church called it.

Slower, less dramatic; more routine – even ordinary...but every bit as daunting, faithful, powerful and beautiful – *like the love of our Moms, bringing us to birth, and nurturing us all along the way!*

If Easter is true, and Jesus' Power brought Him back from the dead, then we've got the power to give ourselves away, without fear: dramatically & heroically, or slowly and faithfully over time.

We can do this!

We can give ourselves to a spouse, to a child, to a great task, vision, challenge or ideal!

We can give our 20's or 30's or whatever our 'prime time' is,

to a job, a 'vocation', a dream, an ideal!

We can give ourselves to the Church, to a parish, as a priest, a deacon, a woman or man celibate religious. We can give our ideas, efforts, time, talents treasure away,

for the Glory of God and the building up of the Eternal Kingdom and the Earthly Church! Think about it: "Who has given themselves to & for you? For whom have you returned the favor?" As we give ourselves away in Jesus' Love & Victory,

"God bless us... EVERY one"!
