Rose, Mary & Tim – Dads, Sons; Holy Spirit & Summer Details



Today is Fathers' Day, in our national calendar. *We love you Dads - of all sorts! We thank you; and pray for you; and treasure you for earth & Heaven!* his past week, I joined 100 other parish priests, from the all over the Diocese of Green Bay for our annual retreat, at the Green Lake Conference Center. Green Lake is Wisconsin's deepest lake at 1,500 feet.

Along with renewing old friendships, it was a great chance to get to know some of the many **International Priests** who serve here – far away from family and homeland. I admire so much their zeal, sacrifice & brotherhood! Many are from the Philippines & India (including 3 Norbertines), where COVID is still wreaking havoc. One man couldn't go home to India for his Dad's funeral a couple weeks ago!

Fr. Jon Vander Ploeg, the Director of Spiritual Formation at St. John Vianney Seminary in St. Paul, Minnesota was our retreat-master. His theme: *"Responding to the Holy Spirit"*.

Bishop David Ricken shared from his retreat last year how the Holy Spirit had powerfully reached into his soul to remind him: *"Remember David, you're working for me; I'm not working for you."* (It's easy for us clerics to get that 'bass-ackwards!') It was a powerful and compelling witness from our Shepherd!

And Fr. Jon's talks were humble, honest, deep, practical and 'convicting'. A real good experience of Confession, some time to think, walk, visit and pray has really 'reset my clock', especially in my ministry to you, here at St. Mary's & St. Rose. And last year's retreat having been scrapped because of COVID lockdown, it was just 'really good to be together' as a fraternity of priests, serving in parish life in this Diocese!

Then, with the good summer weather, there's 'Maintenance Projects' at both parishes to update:

At St. Mary's:

1) *The lane in the Cemetery will be repaved.* Already last week, the old layer had been ground down and hauled away. This \$38K project was budgeted for this year. It will enhance our beautiful cemetery, and honor those who wait for the Resurrection of the Dead in that 'holy ground'.

2) *The Prayer Garden* is looking beautiful, thanks to a lot of hard work from **Tim & Sandy Wanta**.

3) *The Buildings & Grounds Committee* has been very busy prioritizing projects and acquiring bids for a number of improvements on our campus. **Tom Neely** chairs this effort. *We are very grateful to them.*

At St. Rose:

1) *The 1893 Steeple Refurbishing Project* will be starting this coming week, weather permitting. This work is a Memorial to **Tom Furdek**. *We are very grateful for this gift!*

2) *The Bell updating/digitalizing* will take place later this summer – thanks to a number of kind memorials, and some capital improvement funds.

3) *A glass floor will soon be installed as a 'bridge' at the Baptistry; the internal pump* will be replaced; and an anonymous donor (some time ago) shared an autographed copy of artist, **John Nava's** "Baptism of the Lord" tapestry, from Our Lady of the Angels Cathedral in Los Angeles, California. *We're grateful that this fundamental Christian sacrament is honored & celebrated in this refurbished setting.*

Please, remember as well, that with the **Fireworks Display** returning to Clintonville on July 2nd this year, **St. Rose/St. Mary's School Concessions Stand** will be up & running on our front lawn – the best place in town to watch this great display of fireworks!

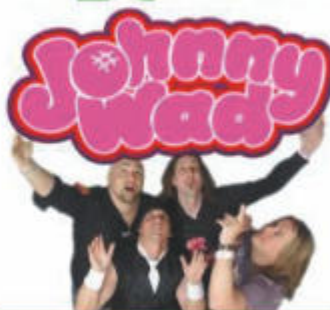
Knights of Columbus Tootsie Roll Drive
