

Rose, Mary & Tim: Jumping into 2022 with both feet!



This year, we have the longest possible stretch of <u>'Ordinary Time'</u> (counting Sundays by numbers – 'ordinals') before Lent begins on March 2nd. Both by way of <u>review & forecast</u>, there's lots to share from our life together at SSRM! * At St. Rose - Hopefully, you've 'heard' –

literally – that the bells in the steeple have been refurbished, & a new Carillon has been installed. It's met with

many positive, grateful comments, smiles and good memories.

The workers shared <u>before & after</u> photos. Our 2 bells no longer swing; instead, hammers strike



them. This solution causes much less stress, wear & tear on the bells, the mechanics, and the 1893 steeple structure itself.

You can also see one of the 4 speakers, which broadcasts the new Carillon – with a selection of over 5,300 songs, hymns, peals and tolls. We're hoping to train a small crew of interested folks to monitor the use of this

beautiful gift. Meanwhile, the bells are timed to ring the Angelus at noon & 6pm daily; to ring 'on the hour' from 8am to 7pm daily; and to ring 5 minutes before the start of Masses.

A 'thank you' list & an 'event', to rededicate the steeple are in the works; for now, look up, listen & smile!

<u>At St. Mary's</u> - Tom Neely, Chair of the Buildings & Grounds Committee, along with Terry Mares, made a presentation of the proposed <u>Roof Replacement for the 1920 Church & 1937 Parish House</u>, after Mass last weekend. Including the asbestos abatement, the project will run close to \$200K.

We have the money. The presentation was not to raise funds. Rather it was to keep the whole Community informed, & to welcome questions & feedback – part of the "Proxy Process" (Diocesan permission when a project goes over \$100K). Tom & Terry reminded the Assembly of the importance of regular Sunday envelope support and the support of the annual Bishop's Appeal. The Kulp Company from Stratford, WI has been selected. The target construction start date is for August, 2022, right after the 2022 Sauerkraut Festival.

<u>At St. Rose</u> - Rita Hicks Braund, has concluded her term on the Finance Council; relocating from Clintonville, she declined another term. Rita has been a long-time, insightful, faith-filled, common sense, conscientious member of this important committee. *We thank her; and we wish her & Ed well in their new adventures!*

Since the appointments to this council are the pastor's to make, I'm glad to share that <u>Andy Heckman</u> has accepted a 3-year term on the Finance Council having begun in December. He is a faith-filled, intelligent, thoughtful and wise parishioner. *Thank you for being willing to serve, Andy!* For our 1 Community of Faith at SSRM –

* During this stretch of Diocesan focus on the importance of Sunday Mass – "WORSHIP JESUS" - we have scheduled **3 weekends of Teaching Masses on** <u>Saturday/Sunday, February 12/13, 19/20, and 25/26</u>.
