

Dear Brothers & Sisters of SSRM!



On Memorial Day...

A good friend, *Jeff Van Pietersom*, texted me, and flew up in his small plane to Clintonville Municipal Airport, where he said, gas prices are better than Madison. He's a former Navy Pilot, flying now for

FedEx. On his way to see his brother in Crandon, he made time to take me up for a 'fly-over' of SSRM.

I would have expected to feel more timid about accepting Jeff's offer, but his joy & eagerness to share with me "God's gift to him" – being a pilot & having a plane - made it impossible to decline! I'm glad I went! It turned out to be a blast! Great fun!

It was wonderful & beautiful to see Clintonville & Bear Creek; St. Rose & St. Mary's from a 'different angle'.

The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity:

Today, the Church celebrates the Holy Trinity, and offers us a similar invitation:

To see God 'from a different angle'.





Many times, preachers simply define the Trinity as a 'mystery' – impossible to grasp or understand, so don't try. I've done that myself. Other times, preachers use shamrocks, triangles, BLT sandwiches or other 'triads' to make comparisons – which limp along and can be quickly forgotten.

A few years ago, it struck me that the Trinity is much more simple (and challenging) than all of that: Three distinct Persons, who get along, all the time. Each one is unique and has their own work to do; all three love each other and trust each other; they respect each other's differences; they serve each other, not themselves. No one tries to do the other's work. In this simple-but-amazing 'getting along' is created such unity, harmony, healing, peace and freedom which all reveals the Divine!

We all know from experience, how hard it is to 'get along' with others: spouses, parents & children, co-workers, neighbors, colleagues, employees & bosses, teachers & students, men & women, rich & poor...and on and on...and on!

But God the Holy Trinity – Father, Son & Holy Spirit – can do it! And God the Holy Trinity desires us and empowers us to do this as well! That's why our Faith, while being a 'personal', even intimate, relationship with God, is also a Communal one. That's why the Church makes sense. We can't draw closer to God without getting close to others who are seeking God...rubbing shoulders with them as we search!

St. Rose/St. Mary's – A Community of Faith

My understanding is that sometime after *Fr. Dennis Worzalla* retired, as the last residential pastor of St. Mary's, representatives from Bear Creek approached *Msgr. Mark Schommer*, the pastor of St. Rose. They requested he 'take on' the pastoral duties of St. Mary's as an additional ministry. He agreed. *Our Community of Faith was seeded in that 'deal'*.

Not a linkage; not a merger; not a closure; but something new! Each parish keeps its checkbook & financials, its name, identity, history and 'personality'. But together <u>BOTH parishes</u> began to share in new ways which were both required by circumstances, and also opportunities to make better use of our resources, time, talent and treasure.

I understand that this change took place against the backdrop of some unresolved 'hard feelings' dating to the closure of the Bear Creek Public School District (around 1971) and the transferring of those students to Clintonville. Some of this was 'aired out' in the Town Hall Meetings we held on our own recent School Discernment.

In some ways, our 2 parishes are like the Trinity – unique, distinct persons, who, for the sake of Gospel Mission, need to respect each other and get along. In some ways, that's happening; in others and among some folks, it's not.

So I can't miss the opportunity today to make a plea for each one of us, and all of us together – to take a page from the Holy Trinity's playbook. Look at ourselves from a 'higher altitude'. With only a few weeks left with you, I plead with you: Put the past in the past; resolve to get along, respectfully, efficiently, gladly, so that the Holy Trinity – the Presence of God – can be seen & experienced among us, and be a compelling force for others to join us at SSRM! "God bless us... EVERY one!"


