

## Family Ministry



### "Uniting People Living in Faith and Truth"

**UPLIFT Family Formation Program** is a religious education program serving the parents and children of the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist and the Family of Four Parishes. Our program is designed to support and equip PARENTS to be the primary educators of the faith for their children, and assist UPLIFT families to live in the fullness of our Catholic faith as disciples and followers of Jesus Christ. Since October the families have been meeting on Zoom every other week to participate in their lessons, small group activities, fun games and scripture reflections. Lessons for each year are focused on one of the four pillars of the Catechism. Last year we focused on the seven Sacraments, and this year the focus is on **prayer**.

After spending two months on an in-depth study of the Lord's Prayer, families will learn about Mary in February. Despite the changes to virtual meetings, the UPLIFT families have been fully engaged and proactive in our meetings. UPLIFT families have not only been learning and praying more, but they have been serving more! This December, UPLIFT families adopted five families in our community and generously purchased over 100 gifts this Christmas. It has been wonderful to witness how the Holy Spirit is alive and working in these UPLIFT families.


