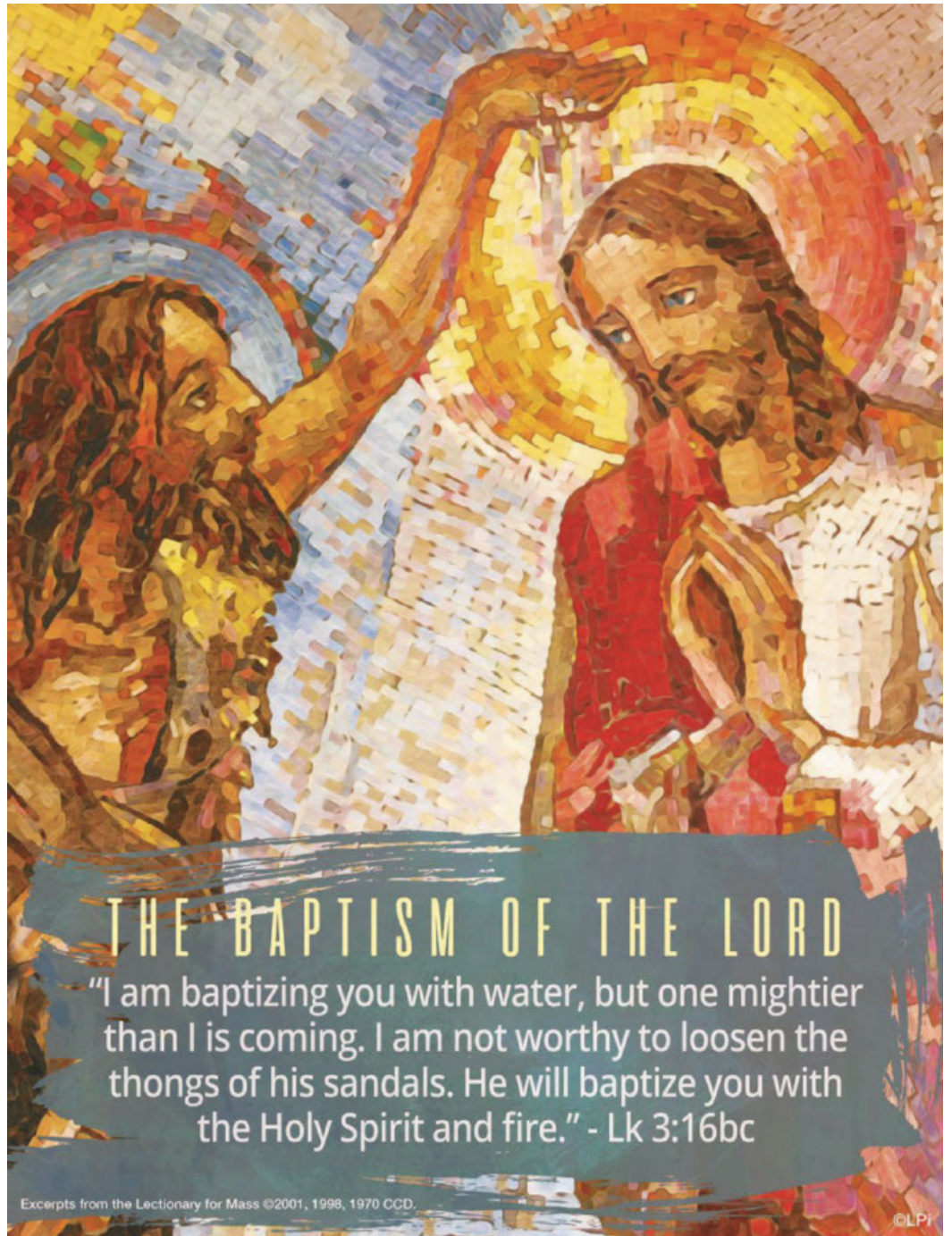

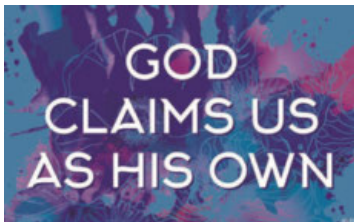

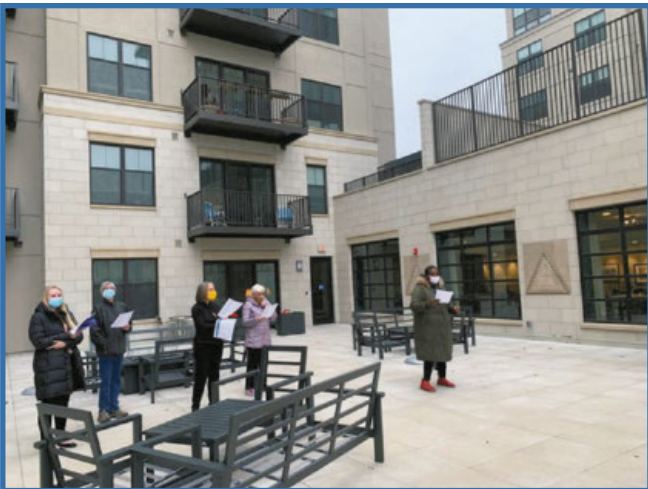


Father Gene's Help Center

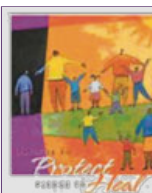

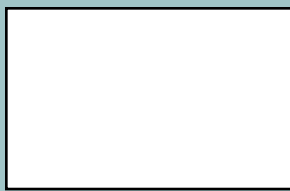
