Wiseman have come from near and far.

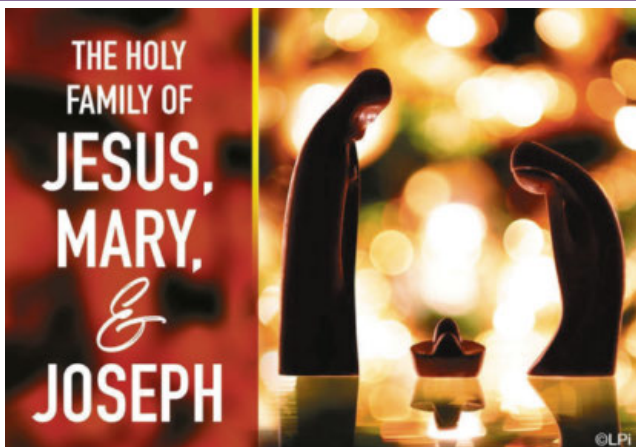
I've met all our dear ones

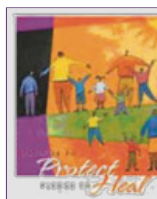
