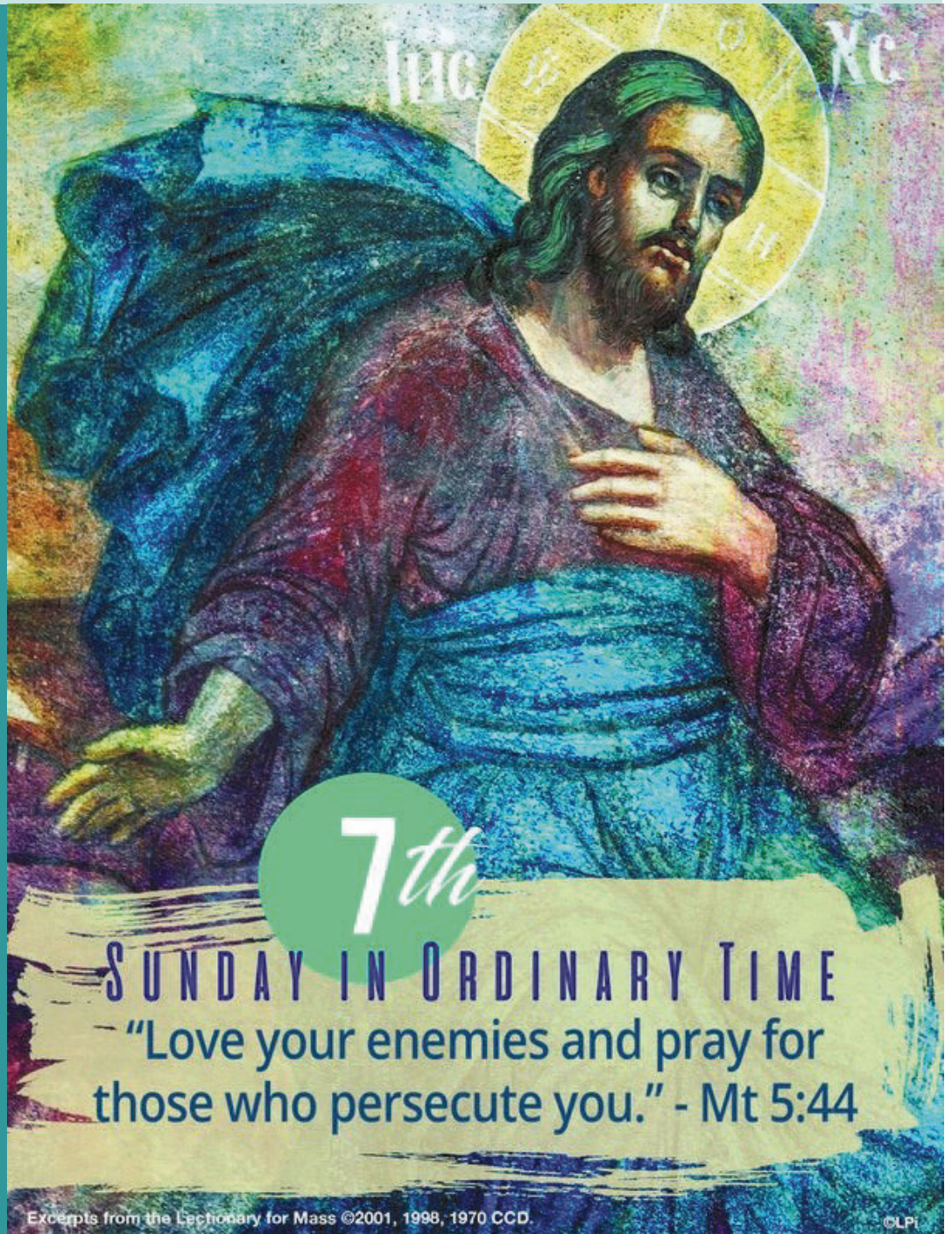

Dear Friends,

Our dear friend Fr. Mike Bertram, pastor of St. Francis of Assisi Parish, and his parishioner Carl Carby composed this beautiful reflection used at the annual Archdiocesan Memorial prayer service honoring the legacy of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. I present it to you for your prayer and reflection as we all work together for a just and peaceful community:



Pledge to acknowledge the SACREDNESS OF ALL LIFE

I pledge myself this day to the Gospel call of Jesus to recognize the presence of God in everyone and in all that is around me.

I make a fundamental, conscious choice to choose life and not death; to choose light and not darkness; to choose good and not evil; to choose peace and not discord.

I pledge myself to respect the life and dignity of every human person: of the unborn, of the aged, of the imprisoned.

In imitation of Jesus, I pledge to work on behalf of the poor and the vulnerable, the homeless and the hungry, the widow and the orphan, the lesser ones in our midst, the powerless and those without influence in our society.

After the example of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., I pledge to live justly, in a non-violent manner, so as to promote peace. I pledge to work for the well-being of all people of color, of the immigrant and disenfranchised, and of those barred from full participation in the governing of our society.

Like the prophet Micah, I make this pledge to act justly, to love tenderly and to walk humbly with my God - a God who makes a way where there is no way, especially in the temptations and challenges that life presents to me.

Have a blessed week. Let's remember each other in prayer.

After the funeral, when the cards and flowers have stopped coming, most of the people around you return to their normal lives. But your grief continues and you feel alone. Often, friends and family want to help you, but don't know how. That's the reason for GriefShare. Our group will be led by caring people who have experienced grief and successfully rebuilt their lives. We understand how you feel, because we've been in the same place. We will walk with you on the long path through grief toward healing and hope for the future.

What to expect: GriefShare is a support group that meets weekly. You'll find it to be a warm, caring environment, and will come to see your group as an "oasis" on your long journey through grief. There are three key parts to your GriefShare experience:

- ◆ Video Seminar – Encouraging, information-packed videos, featuring leading grief recovery experts.
- ◆ Support group – Small group discussion about the weekly video content.
- ◆ Workbook – Journaling and personal study exercises that reinforce the weekly session topics. There is a \$20.00 fee for the workbook. Scholarships are available.

SVDP Love Story



A recent experience jolted me into thinking about something that surrounds me, but that I was not mindful of until now. I went house hunting with my daughter for her family's first home. Within the same week, I made a home visit to one of our neighbors as a volunteer for Six Saints St. Vincent de Paul Conference. The contrast of these two experiences was dramatic and mind opening for me. While my daughter and this other young woman are approximately the same age and have children of similar ages, their circumstances are incredibly different. One mother dreams of a home in a safe community with good schools. She does not think about beds and appliances; those 'basics' do not enter her mind because she knows they will be part of her new home. The other mother worries about basics. Her apartment is almost empty. She hopes someone can help her with beds for her children, a stove and something to sit on. The causes for this inequality are numerous and complicated – and the problem is growing. This is why the work of organizations like St. Vincent de Paul is important and so worthy of your support.

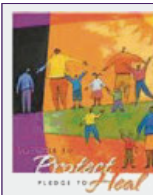
