Hello, Family of Five Parishes!



Stay safe this week, and love God and your neighbor as you celebrate freedom.







Love Thy Neighbor

On July 4, we remember and celebrate our country's founding ideals: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights..." We also remember that at the time of the signing of the Declaration of Independence in 1776, about twenty percent of the colonial population was enslaved with no rights. Those words were clearly not yet meant for ALL Americans. Yet today, we can all honor our founders' words for articulating values that would later guide and direct our nation. It took almost 200 years of struggle to legislate and affirm liberty and equal rights for Black Americans, but eventually progress was made, and we honor the many Catholics and others who contributed to that progress.

How do we sustain progress? "Remember your history, your long and rich history." (Isaiah 46:9). One way we can do this is by visiting Milwaukee's Black Holocaust Museum. It respectfully welcomes all people to visit, remember, and learn about our shared racial history and the journey our Nation has taken. "Moving our nation to a full realization of the promise of liberty, equality, and justice for all is... challenging. However, in Christ we can find the strength and the grace necessary to make that journey." (USCCB, *Open Wide Our Hearts*). 
