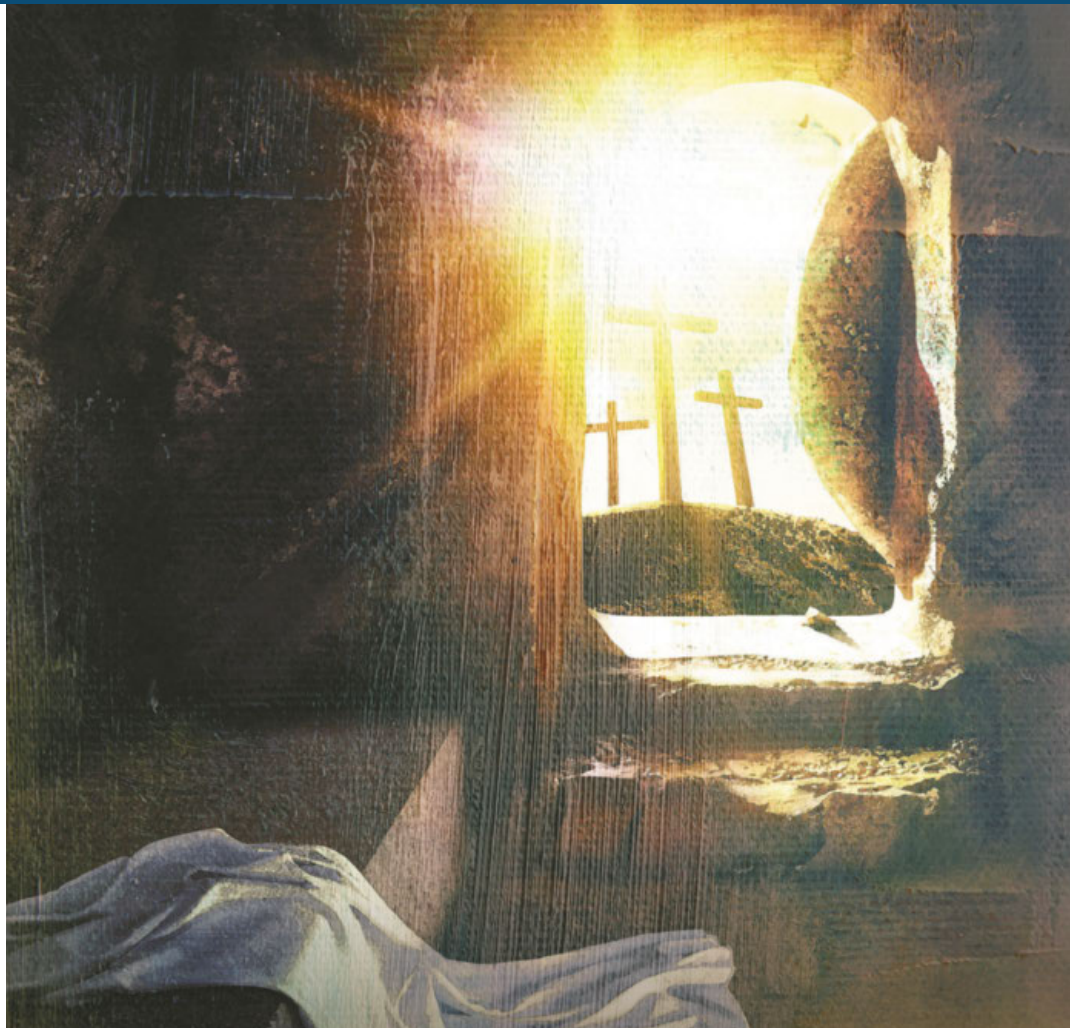

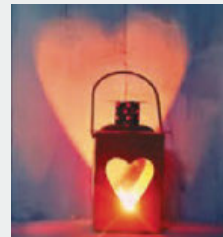


## Pastoral Care
