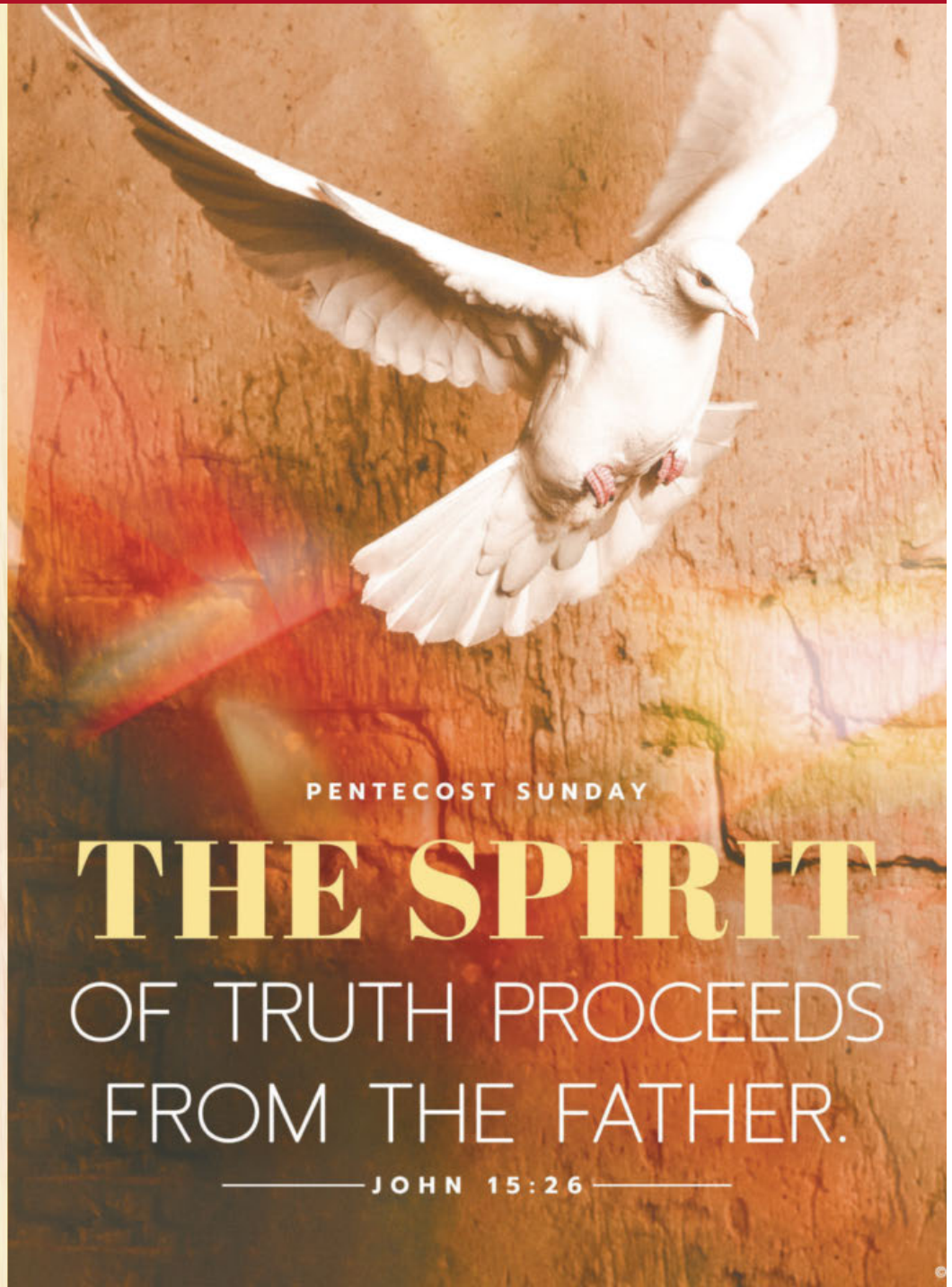

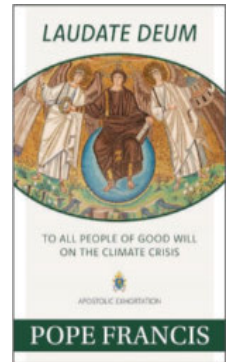

This document builds on Pope Francis's 2015 encyclical entitled *Laudate Si* on the environment. As noted in *America Magazine*, *Laudate Deum* is a "precisely focused call to action, urging all people of good will to make greater efforts in relation to the climate crisis."
