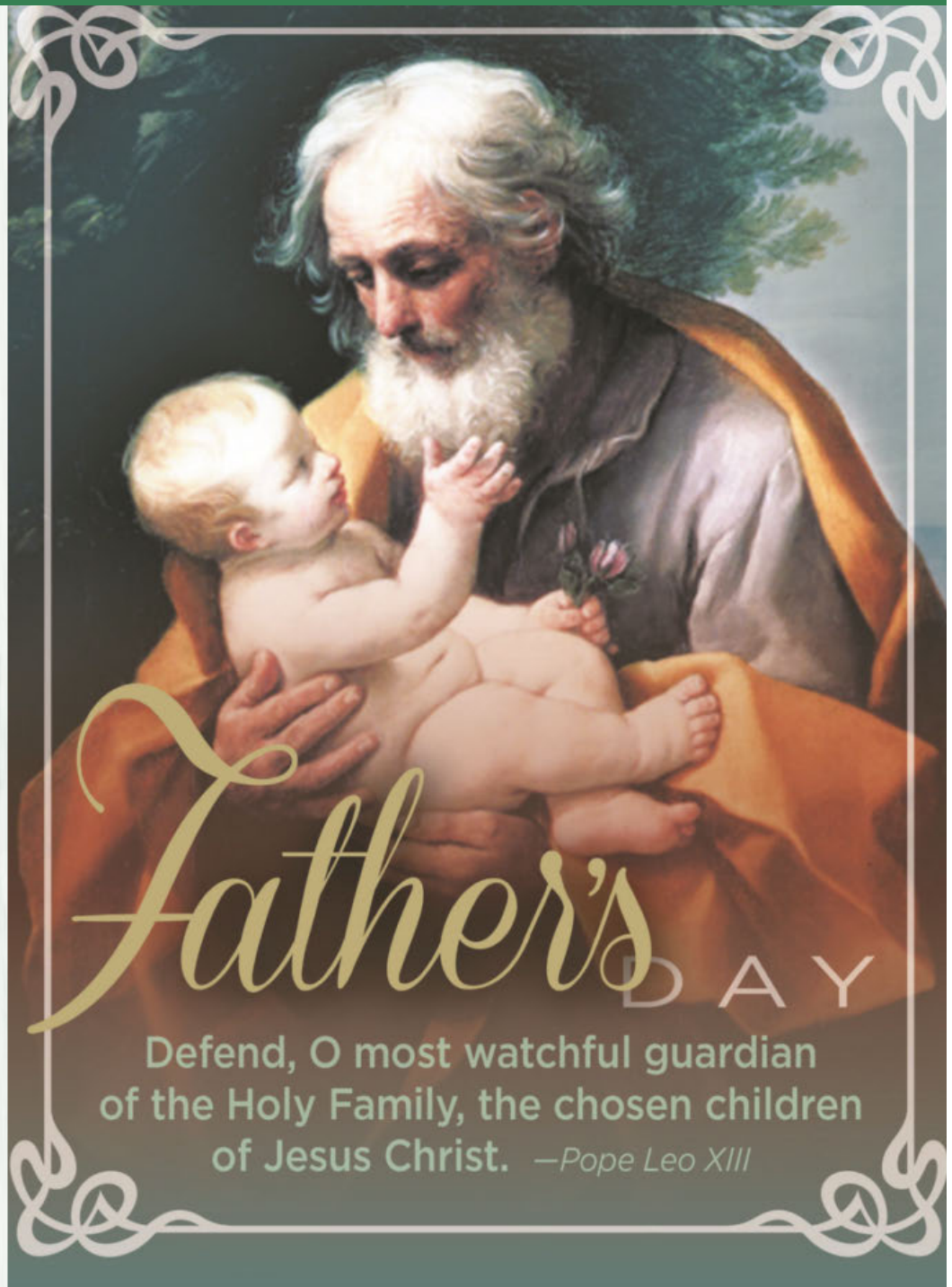

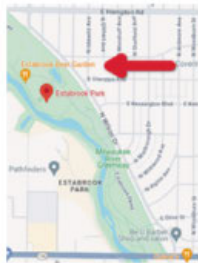

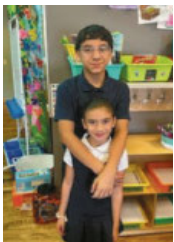
Catholic East Elementary

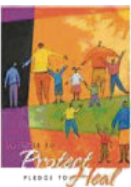

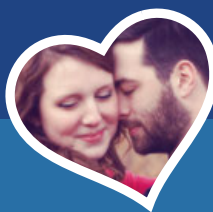
