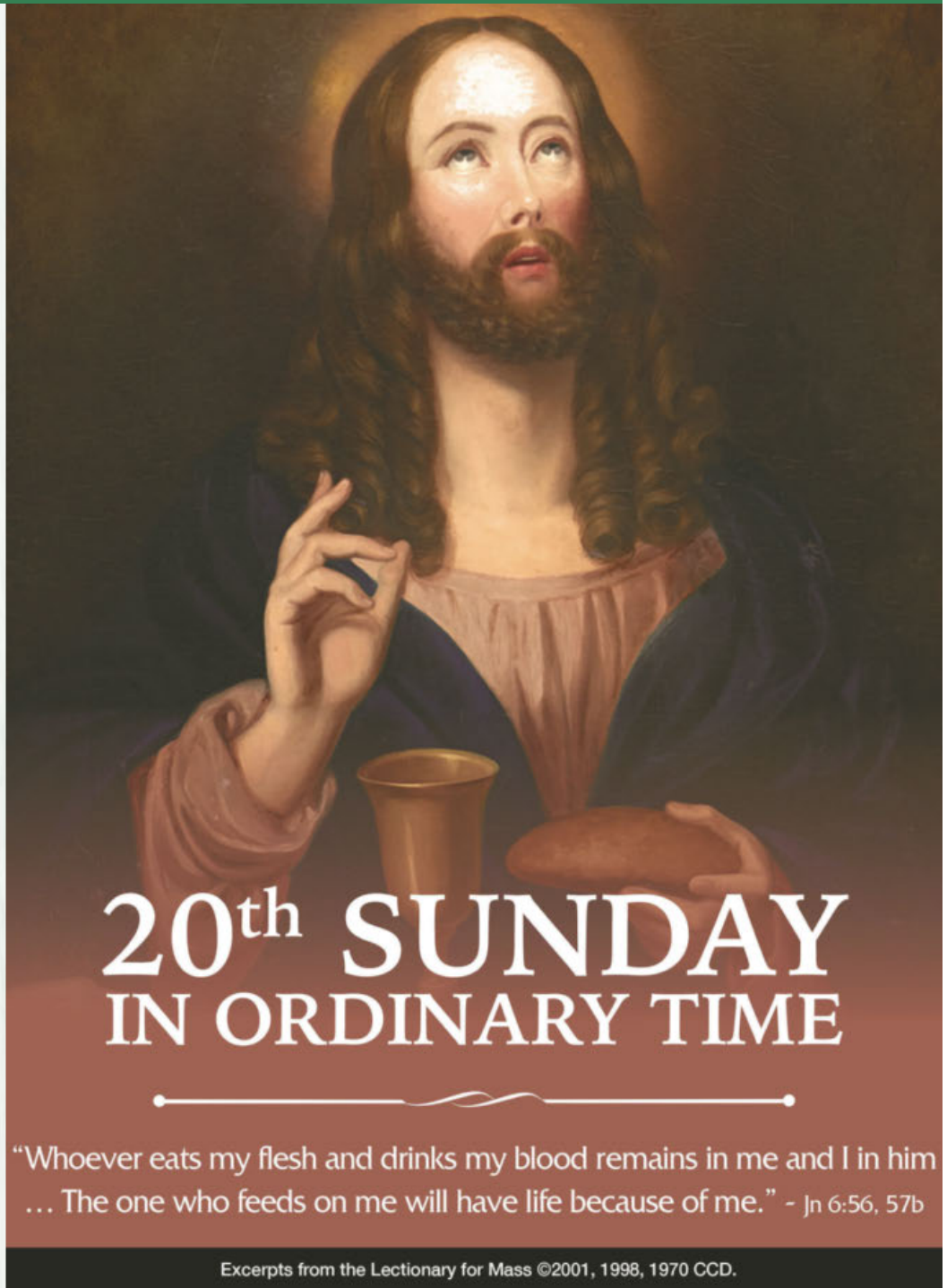

We are continuing our midsummer break from the Gospel of Mark for the fourth of five weeks as we read through the "Bread of Life" discourse in the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John. Healing the Whole Person: Engaging Your Story is an 8-week series that provides the framework for understanding and receiving Christ's healing and peace in the heart of the Catholic Church.

We are using videos featuring Dr. Bob Schuchts and Sr. Miriam James Heidland presenting the John Paul II Healing Center's Healing the Whole Person teachings. 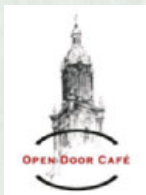
