Dear friends,

This weekend, the letter of Saint
James invites us to live out the Chris-
tian life in a very intentional way.

In society today, it is easy to treat
people differently according to their status or the favors
they can provide. Some make "social calculations" and
decide in their hearts what people are worth being kind
towards or patient with, and what people are not. Friend-
ship becomes a form of currency and those who do not
represent a "benefit" are treated poorly, and little effort is
made to show them care and respect.

The invitation for the Christian people this weekend is
clear, namely, to "show no partiality" in the way we treat
others. We are all created in the image and likeness of
God (Gen 1:27), and everyone deserves to be treated
with dignity and respect, as beloved children of God. As
Saint Paul says in his letter to the Romans, "love one
another with mutual affection; anticipate one another in
showing honor" (12:10.)

May the Holy Spirit help us live out the Christian life as
Christ has taught us!

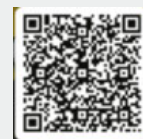


Engagement Social Tuesday September 10

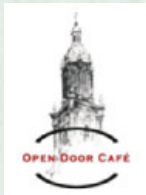

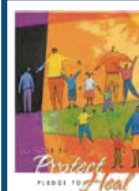

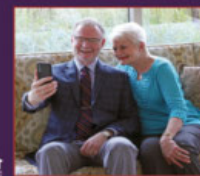
