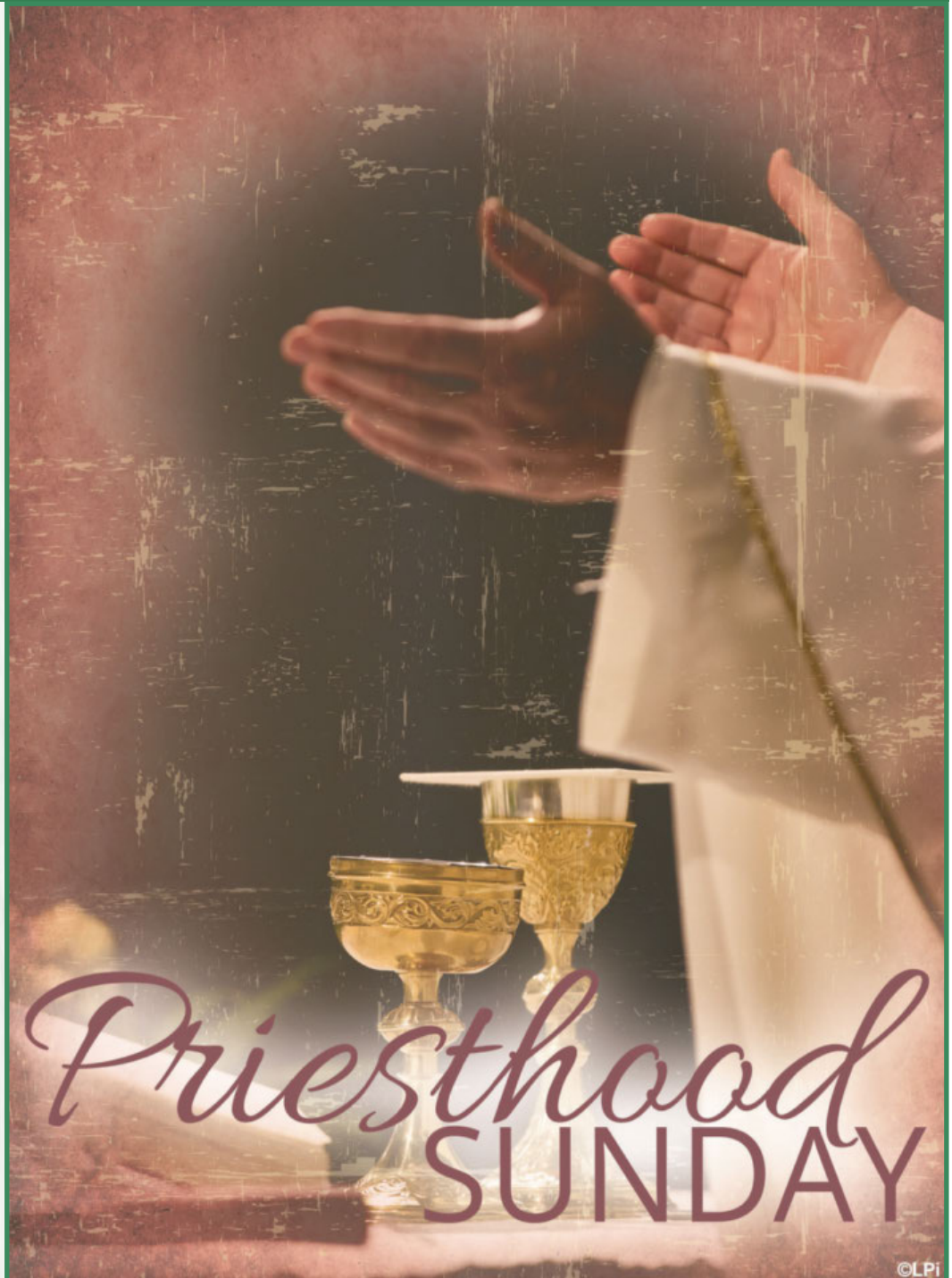

### First Friday Eucharistic Adoration

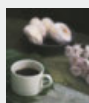
