



Did you know? St. Hedwig Church at 1702 N. Humboldt Ave. is an 1887 structure of Gothic and Romanesque styles. It replaced a much more modest wooden structure originally built on Franklin Place where Mass was first celebrated on October 17, 1871. It was erected for and by the Polish inhabitants of the city. An elementary school, grades 1-8, was also part of this parish. The present edifice stands in a recently revived community of homes and small businesses known as the Brady Street neighborhood.
