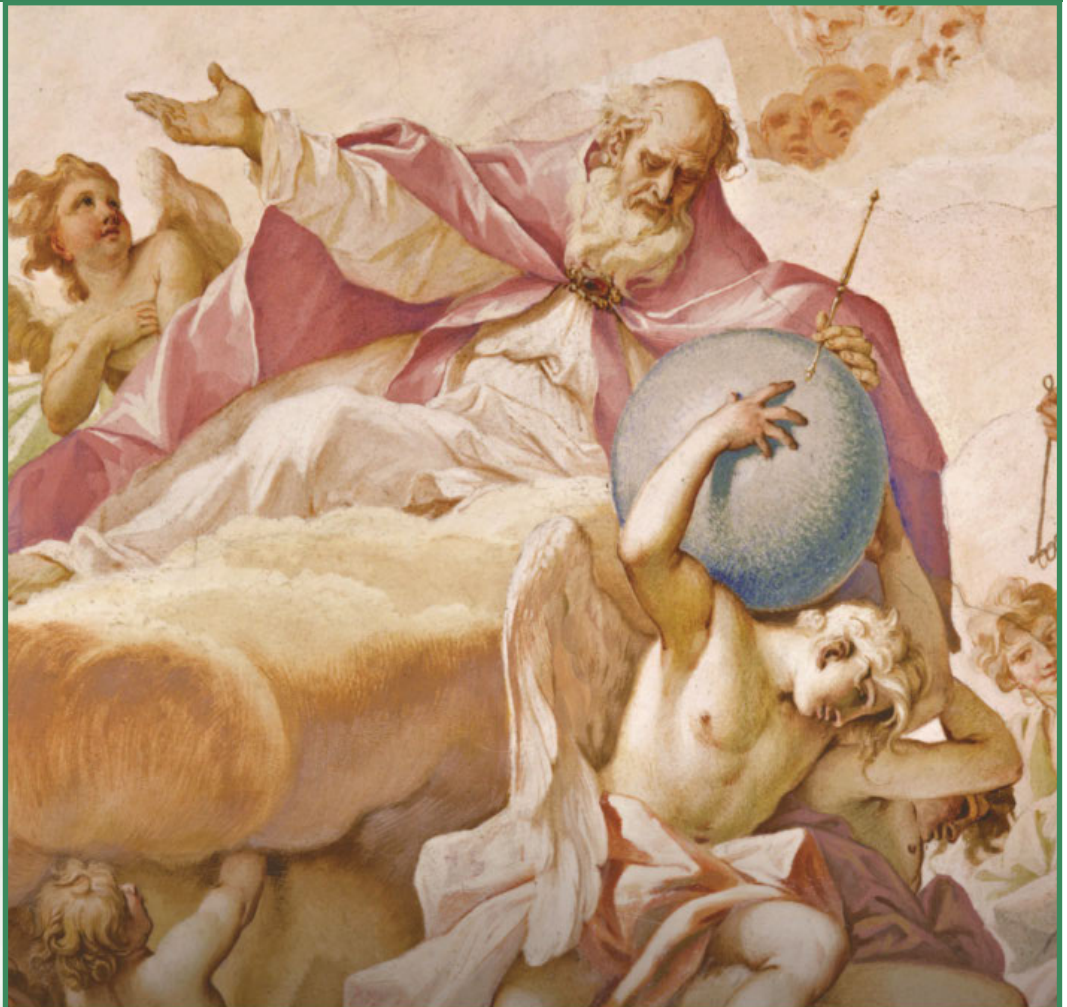

### St. Vincent de Paul Society of Milwaukee

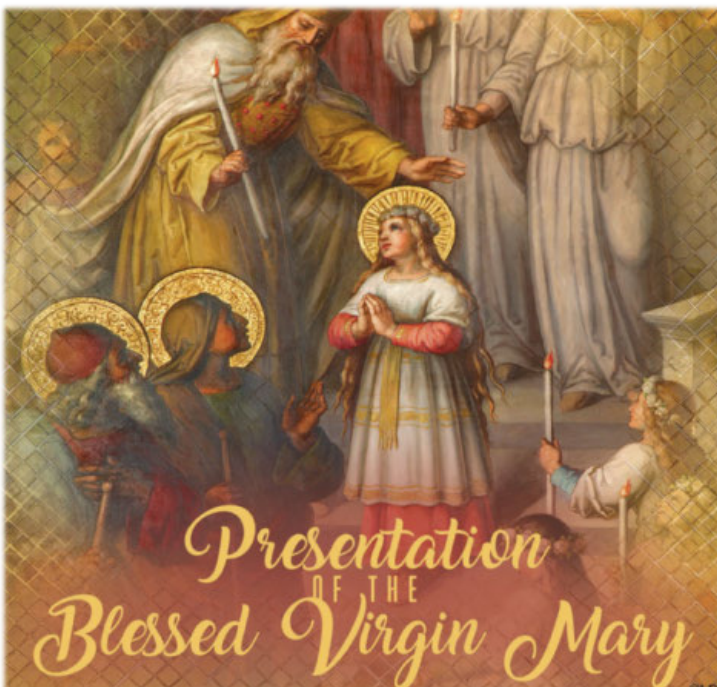
