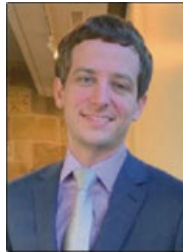

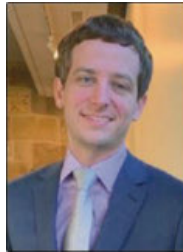

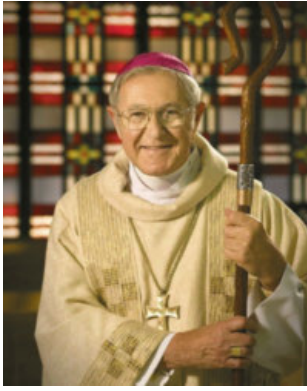
Mark your calendar: Spaghetti Dinner on February 2

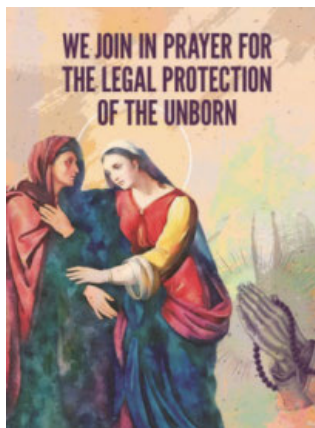

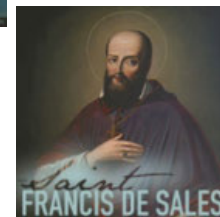

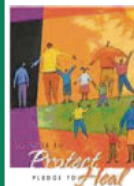
