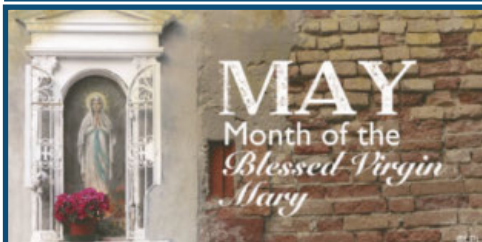

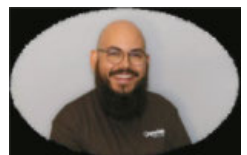

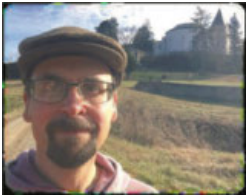

Reflecting on the Sunday Readings



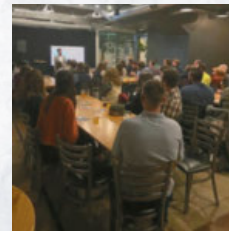

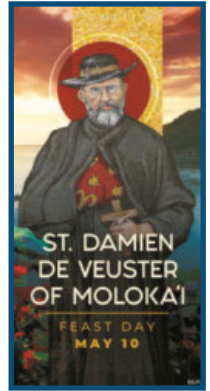
