

Dear Friends.

Happy Feast of the Ascension! As I reflect on the story of Jesus' return to the Father, I find myself relating to the disciples who must have been amazed at the glory of the situation, but if they were like me, they would be asking themselves, "What now?"

I am a planner and try to be two steps ahead of any situation so I can do my best job and get things done efficiently. The Ascension would have thrown me for a loop. Jesus was sure and certain in his proclamation of God's Kingdom and what needed to be done to make that Kingdom come about.
