Pastor's Corner



As I write my final bulletin column for the parishes, I want to take this opportunity to **THANK YOU** for three wonderful years of priestly ministry. These days have been bittersweet. The sorrow comes from saying goodbye to so many parishioners and friends. At the same time, there has been joy—especially in the recent visit from my parents, who came to Milwaukee for the first time. They felt warmly welcomed and left with full hearts,

deeply grateful for the kindness and hospitality they experienced in such a short visit. (They even helped me clean my apartment!)

Next weekend, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, a beautiful occasion to honor the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist—His Body and Blood under the appearance of bread and wine. It is also a celebration of the Body of Christ that we are as a Church. Over these past three years, you have been a beautiful reflection of that Body to me. I hope that, despite my human limitations, I have been the same for you.

As I've mentioned in some of my homilies, the "politics" that sometimes surrounds priestly ministry is my least favorite part of this vocation. Yet I have always found deep consolation in the People of God—that is, in each of you. You are the reason I wanted to become a priest, along with Jesus Himself (whose Body you are!), and you continue to be the reason I carry out my sacred duties each day.

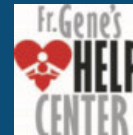

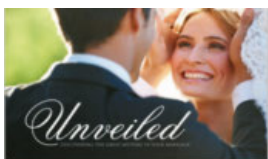

Love Story



St. Vincent de Paul Society of Milwaukee

Jeanne and I went on a home visit. We met "Vicki" who lives in a one-bedroom apartment in an older building in the 53206 zip code. She found her apartment online. "Vicki" recently moved from Chicago to be closer to her grown sons, who live in Milwaukee. She did not know that the neighborhood she chose to live in is not always safe. "Vicki" has to find another apartment and move again as soon as possible. She does not have a lease, so she is free to leave.

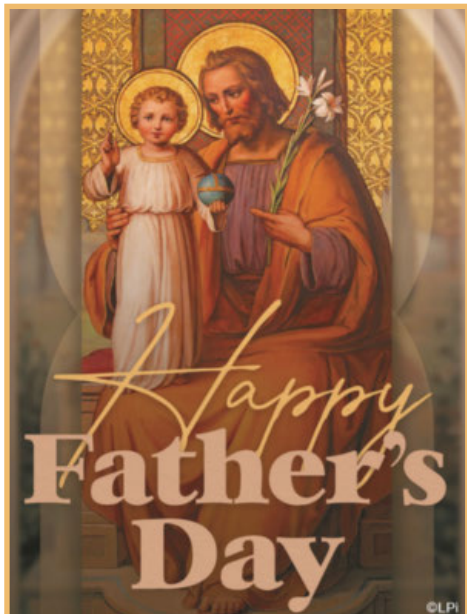
There are other problems in her life. "Vicki" lives on Medicaid due to mental health issues. Twenty years ago, she left a domestic violence situation. After all these years, she still deals with some of the same problems. She is currently seeking a restraining order against an individual.

"Vicki" asked Saint Vincent de Paul's assistance for a bed, household items, clothing, and furniture. She told us she is currently sleeping on a blow-up bed that deflates every night. We were able to give "Vicki" a new full bed and a gift certificate to our thrift store for furniture. We took bedding and kitchen items on our visit.

I am always surprised at how willing our neighbors are to share their personal stories. We are strangers when we arrive. By listening to these stories of joy and suffering, we discover a beautiful connection with one another. We are grateful that God not only calls us to this vocation, but time and time again, He chooses us to come to Him.

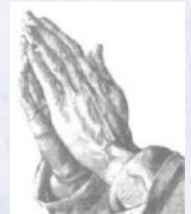

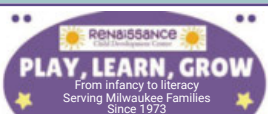
