


Hello Family of Five Parishes,



We are ready to start on the 2025 Catholic Coalition House. The next scheduled work date is Saturday, July 5th for Siding (2 spots available.)




The registration deadline is June 26 (4 volunteers are registered.) All volunteers MUST be over the age of 16 and register at least 24 hours in advance.


