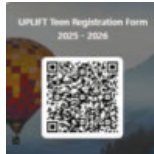
Special Collection

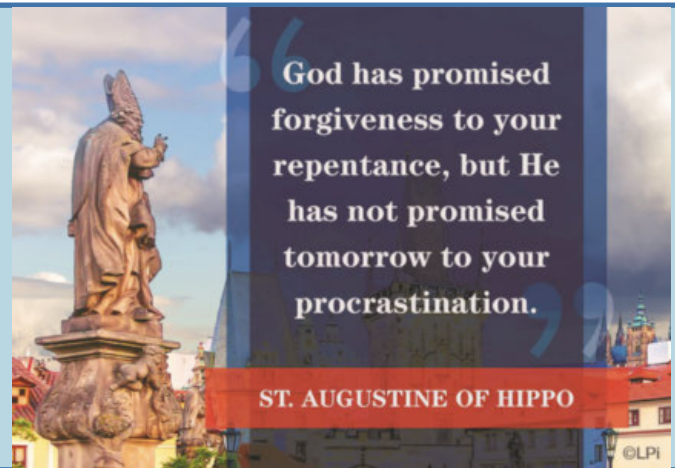
