La Sagrada Familia Sister Parish's Letter



Dear Parishioners,

We are excited to share a report with you on the happenings at our Sister Parish La Sagrada Familia over the past few months. We traveled to our Sister Parish at the beginning of March to see an amazing structure built to benefit the residents of Azua and the surrounding area. A new state-of-the-art health clinic, approximately 3,477 sq ft, was built to replace a much smaller clinic of just over 2,000 sq ft. There is a much larger waiting room area with public restrooms, a cashier's office, 3 doctors' offices with adjoining restrooms, a Physical Therapy area, an Ultrasound office, a small garden space, and a lunchroom for staff. Electrical power for the entire clinic will be operated, mostly if not entirely, by solar panels once funds are obtained to complete this portion of the project.

The Government of the Dominican Republic will supply a doctor, a nurse practitioner, and two nurses to provide medical care to over 20,000 residents in this area. With the nearest large hospital being over a 3-hour drive away, this new facility and staffing will be better positioned to fill the healthcare gap in the community and the greater region.

We were asked by Fr. Javier to take part in the dedication and blessing of the clinic by Most Reverend Tomas Alejo Concepcion, Bishop of the San Juan de la Maguana Diocese, where our Sister Parish is located. A portion of the clinic's funding was raised by the Cathedral parishioners and friends of the Cathedral. Thank you!

We also have good news about the young boy, Chai, whom Dolores talked about during the mission appeal in the fall. Chai and his mother are immigrants from Haiti. He is the one who suffered from severe third-degree burns on much of his chest when a kettle of beans fell off the stove. He is doing well and on the road to recovery, now able to manage most of his wound care at the local clinic.

The new Associate Pastor for La Sagrada Familia is Fr. Josegerman Zapata-Ramirez. He is replacing Fr. Rafael Rodriguez, who will be returning to the US for another assignment. Welcome to Fr. Zapata-Ramirez! And a warm thank you to Fr. Rafael Rodriguez for all your service to our sisters and brothers at La Sagrada Familia.

Carta de Nuestra Parroquia Hermana La Sagrada Familia



Queridos feligreses,

Nos entusiasma compartir con ustedes un informe sobre nuestra Parroquia Hermana, La Sagrada Familia, durante los últimos meses. Viajamos a nuestra Parroquia Hermana a principios de marzo para ver una estructura asombrosa construida en beneficio de los residentes de Azua y sus alrededores. Se construyó una nueva clínica de vanguardia de aproximadamente 3.477 pies cuadrados para reemplazar una clínica mucho más pequeña de poco más de 2.000 pies cuadrados. La nueva estructura cuenta con una sala de espera mucho más amplia y con baños públicos, una oficina para el área de pagos, tres consultorios médicos con baños adjuntos, un área de Fisioterapia, una sala de Ecografías, un pequeño espacio con jardín y un comedor para el personal. El suministro eléctrico de toda la clínica funcionará, en su mayor parte, si no en su totalidad, con paneles solares, una vez que se obtengan los fondos necesarios para completar esta etapa del proyecto.

El Gobierno de la República Dominicana asignará un médico, un enfermero especialista y dos enfermeros para brindar atención médica a más de 20.000 residentes de esta zona. Dado que el hospital más cercano se encuentra a más de tres horas de viaje en automóvil, estas nuevas instalaciones y el personal estarán mejor posicionados para cubrir la brecha en la atención médica de la comunidad y de la región en general.

El Padre Javier nos invitó a participar en la inauguración y bendición de la clínica, oficiada por el Excelentísimo Monseñor Tomás Alejo Concepción, Obispo de la Diócesis de San Juan de la Maguana, donde se encuentra nuestra Parroquia Hermana. Una parte de los fondos para la clínica fue recaudada por los feligreses de la Catedral y por amigos y amigas de la misma. ¡Muchas gracias!

También tenemos buenas noticias sobre el niño Chai, de quien Dolores habló durante la campaña misionera del otoño pasado. Chai y su madre son inmigrantes procedentes de Haití. Él es el niño que sufrió quemaduras graves de tercer grado en gran parte del pecho cuando una olla de frijoles se cayó de la estufa. Su evolución es favorable y se encuentra en vías de recuperación; ahora la mayor parte del cuidado de sus heridas está a cargo de la clínica local.

El nuevo Vicario Parroquial de La Sagrada Familia es el Padre Josegerman Zapata-Ramírez. Él reemplazará al Padre Rafael Rodríguez, quien regresará a los Estados Unidos para asumir una nueva asignación. ¡Bienvenido, Padre Zapata-Ramírez! Y un cálido agradecimiento al Padre Rafael Rodríguez por todo su servicio a nuestros hermanos y hermanas en La Sagrada Familia.
