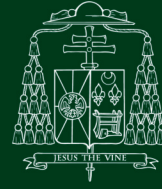

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Pastor's Letter / Carta del Pastor

Dear friends in Christ,

This weekend we celebrate as a nation the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the birthday of the United States of America. With that, I'd like to reflect on that mysterious concept called "the American Dream." It's often reduced to the idea that if you work hard, you can become rich. But I'd like to offer a different vision. There is a family in the community that recently came to the United States. When asked how things were going, the father replied: "It's great. My kids can go to school, there's a park not too far, I have a job; we are blessed." His joy came not from the fact that he was rich, but that his kids can go to school. What if the American Dream was a dream for your children? That if I uproot my life, move to a new place, I can find a life where, through hard work, I can provide for my kids a place of security, opportunity, to grow without fear. The words of St. Paul echo here: "he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves" (2 Cor. 5:15). What if the American Dream was not about oneself, but about giving one's life for the freedom, opportunity, and future of your children?

For the children of immigrants – which is all of us – our parents, grandparents, great-grandparents who came to this country and worked – what if we recognized in them a person "who lived not for themselves," but who gave their lives for our future? For me, this fills me with gratitude. Gratitude and responsibility. Responsibility to "live not for ourselves" but take up the opportunities we have received and carry them worthily – to shape this society. How will we do this?

In *Magnifica Humanitas*, Pope Leo XIV pointed us to the principles of Catholic Social Teaching: Human Dignity, The Universal Destination of Goods, Subsidiarity, Solidarity, and Social Justice. Learn these principles. Use them to challenge politicians of each party, and policies in every dimension of life. Do you really want to automatically follow every Republican policy or every Democrat policy? No – we need principles we can use to evaluate them. Common principles in order to have productive dialogue rather than arguments with repeated talking points. In the next few bulletin letters, I will explain each of these principles. And may they guide us "to live no longer for ourselves, but for him who died and rose again for us."

Queridos amigos en Cristo,

Este fin de semana celebramos como nación el 250.º aniversario de la firma de la Declaración de Independencia, el nacimiento de los Estados Unidos de América. Con este motivo, quisiera reflexionar sobre ese concepto misterioso llamado "el sueño americano". A menudo se reduce a la idea de que, si trabajas duro, puedes hacerte rico. Pero quisiera ofrecer una visión diferente. Hay una familia en la comunidad que llegó recientemente a los Estados Unidos. Cuando se le preguntó cómo iban las cosas, el padre respondió: "Es maravilloso. Mis hijos pueden ir a la escuela, hay un parque no muy lejos, tengo trabajo; estamos bendecidos". Su alegría no provenía del hecho de ser rico, sino de que sus hijos pueden ir a la escuela. ¿Y si el sueño americano fuera un sueño para tus hijos? La idea de que, si desarraigo mi vida y me mudo a un lugar nuevo, puedo encontrar una vida donde, mediante el trabajo duro, pueda brindar a mis hijos un entorno de seguridad y oportunidades, permitiéndoles crecer sin miedo. Aquí resuenan las palabras de San Pablo: "Y Cristo murió por todos para que los que viven, ya no vivan para sí mismos" (2 Corintios, 5:15). ¿Y si el sueño americano no tratara sobre uno mismo, sino sobre dar la vida por la libertad, las oportunidades y el futuro de los hijos?

Para los hijos de inmigrantes, que somos todos nosotros, al pensar en nuestros padres, abuelos y bisabuelos que llegaron a este país y trabajaron, ¿qué pasaría si reconociéramos en ellos a personas que "no vivieron para sí mismas", sino que entregaron sus vidas por nuestro futuro? A mí, esto me llena de gratitud. Gratitude and responsibility. La responsabilidad de "no vivir para nosotros mismos", sino de aprovechar las oportunidades que hemos recibido y llevarlas con dignidad para moldear esta sociedad. ¿Cómo lo haremos?

En *Magnifica Humanitas*, el Papa León XIV nos señaló los principios de la Doctrina Social de la Iglesia: la Dignidad Humana, el Destino Universal de los Bienes, la Subsidiariedad, la Solidaridad y la Justicia Social. Aprendan estos principios. Úsenlos para cuestionar a los políticos de ambos partidos y las políticas en todos los ámbitos de la vida. ¿Realmente quieren seguir automáticamente todas las políticas Republicanas o todas las Demócratas? No; necesitamos principios que nos sirvan para evaluarlas. Principios comunes para mantener un diálogo productivo en lugar de discusiones basadas en argumentos repetitivos. En los próximos mensajes del boletín, explicaré cada uno de estos principios. Que ellos nos guíen "a no vivir para nosotros mismos, sino para aquel que murió y resucitó por nosotros".
