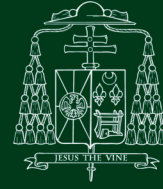

Pastor's Letter / Carta del Pastor

Dear friends in Christ,

It is a truism today to say that every person should be treated with dignity and respect. But why? What is the basis for believing that each person should be treated with dignity, that the vulnerable should be protected? Why shouldn't the dignity and worth we assign people be based purely on their performance, their power, their ability to produce?

For us as Christians, the answer is found in the very beginning of the Bible, in Genesis 1:26-31: "God made mankind in his image; in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them... God looked at everything he had made, and he found it very good." Women and men are made in the *imago Dei*, in the image of God. They are created good, in their essence, in their nature.

This view of humanity is not self-evident. To offer a quick book recommendation, *Dominion: How the Christian Revolution Remade the World* by the secular historian Tom Holland is a nice demonstration of how the Christian worldview departed from the Greco-Roman worldview in ascribing dignity even to slaves, the poor and the infirm. But this view of humanity is the first and most fundamental principle of Christian ethics and of Catholic Social Teaching. Pope Leo XIV, in *Magnifica Humanitas*, recently quoted Pope Francis' words: "Every human person possesses an infinite dignity, inalienably grounded in his or her very being, which prevails in and beyond every circumstance, state, or situation the person may ever encounter" (MG #53).

This human dignity must be made specific. In the words of Pope Francis, "Our defense of the innocent unborn, for example, needs to be clear, firm and passionate, for at stake is the dignity of a human life, which is always sacred and demands love for each person, regardless of his or her stage of development. Equally sacred, however, are the lives of the poor, those already born, the destitute, the abandoned and the underprivileged, the vulnerable infirm and elderly exposed to covert euthanasia, the victims of human trafficking, new forms of slavery, and every form of rejection" (*Gaudete et Exsultate* #101).

Whose dignity are you tempted to forget? The dignity of the immigrant, of the unborn, of the elderly, of the homeless? Or perhaps the dignity of your spouse, child, or in-laws? May God enable us to see each person with His eyes – in their goodness, in hope, made in the image of God.

Queridos amigos en Cristo,

Hoy en día es una verdad evidente que toda persona debe ser tratada con dignidad y respeto. Pero ¿por qué? ¿Cuál es el fundamento para creer que cada persona debe ser tratada con dignidad y que los vulnerables deben ser protegidos? ¿Por qué la dignidad y el valor que atribuimos a las personas no deberían basarse únicamente en su desempeño, su poder o su capacidad de producir?

Para nosotros, como cristianos, la respuesta se encuentra al comienzo de la Biblia, en Génesis 1, 26-31: "Dios creó al ser humano a su imagen; a imagen de Dios lo creó; hombre y mujer los creó... Vio Dios todo lo que había hecho, y era muy bueno". Hombres y mujeres están hechos a *imago Dei*, a imagen de Dios. Son creados buenos, en su esencia, en su naturaleza.

Esta visión de la humanidad no es algo evidente por sí misma. Por citar una recomendación bibliográfica rápida, *Dominio: Cómo la revolución cristiana rehizo el mundo*, del historiador secular Tom Holland, ofrece una excelente demostración de cómo la cosmovisión Cristiana se apartó de la Grecorromana al atribuir dignidad incluso a los esclavos, a los pobres y a los enfermos. Sin embargo, esta visión de la humanidad constituye el principio primero y más fundamental de la ética Cristiana y de la Doctrina Social de la Iglesia. El Papa León XIV, en *Magnífica Humanitas*, citó recientemente las palabras del Papa Francisco: "Toda persona humana posee una dignidad infinita, que se fundamenta inalienablemente en su propio ser, le corresponde a cada persona humana, más allá de toda circunstancia y en cualquier estado o situación en que se encuentre" (MG #53).

Esta dignidad humana debe concretarse. En palabras del Papa Francisco: "La defensa del inocente que no ha nacido, por ejemplo, debe ser clara, firme y apasionada, porque allí está en juego la dignidad de la vida humana, siempre sagrada, y lo exige el amor a cada persona más allá de su desarrollo. Pero igualmente sagrada es la vida de los pobres que ya han nacido, que se debaten en la miseria, el abandono, la postergación, la trata de personas, la eutanasia encubierta en los enfermos y ancianos privados de atención, las nuevas formas de esclavitud, y en toda forma de descarte." (*Gaudete et Exsultate* #101).

¿La dignidad de quién te sientes tentado/a a olvidar? ¿La dignidad del inmigrante, del no nacido, del anciano, de la persona sin hogar? ¿O tal vez la dignidad de tu cónyuge, de tu hijo/a o de tus suegros/as? Que Dios nos permita ver a cada persona con sus ojos, en su bondad, con esperanza y como alguien creado a imagen de Dios.

"Even as the quality of available water is constantly diminishing, in some places there is a growing tendency, despite its scarcity, to privatize this resource, turning it into a commodity subject to the laws of the market. Yet access to safe drinkable water is a basic and universal human right, since it is essential to human survival and, as such, is a condition for the exercise of other human rights. Our world has a grave social debt towards the poor who lack access to drinking water, because they are denied the right to a life consistent with their inalienable dignity.
