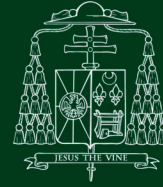


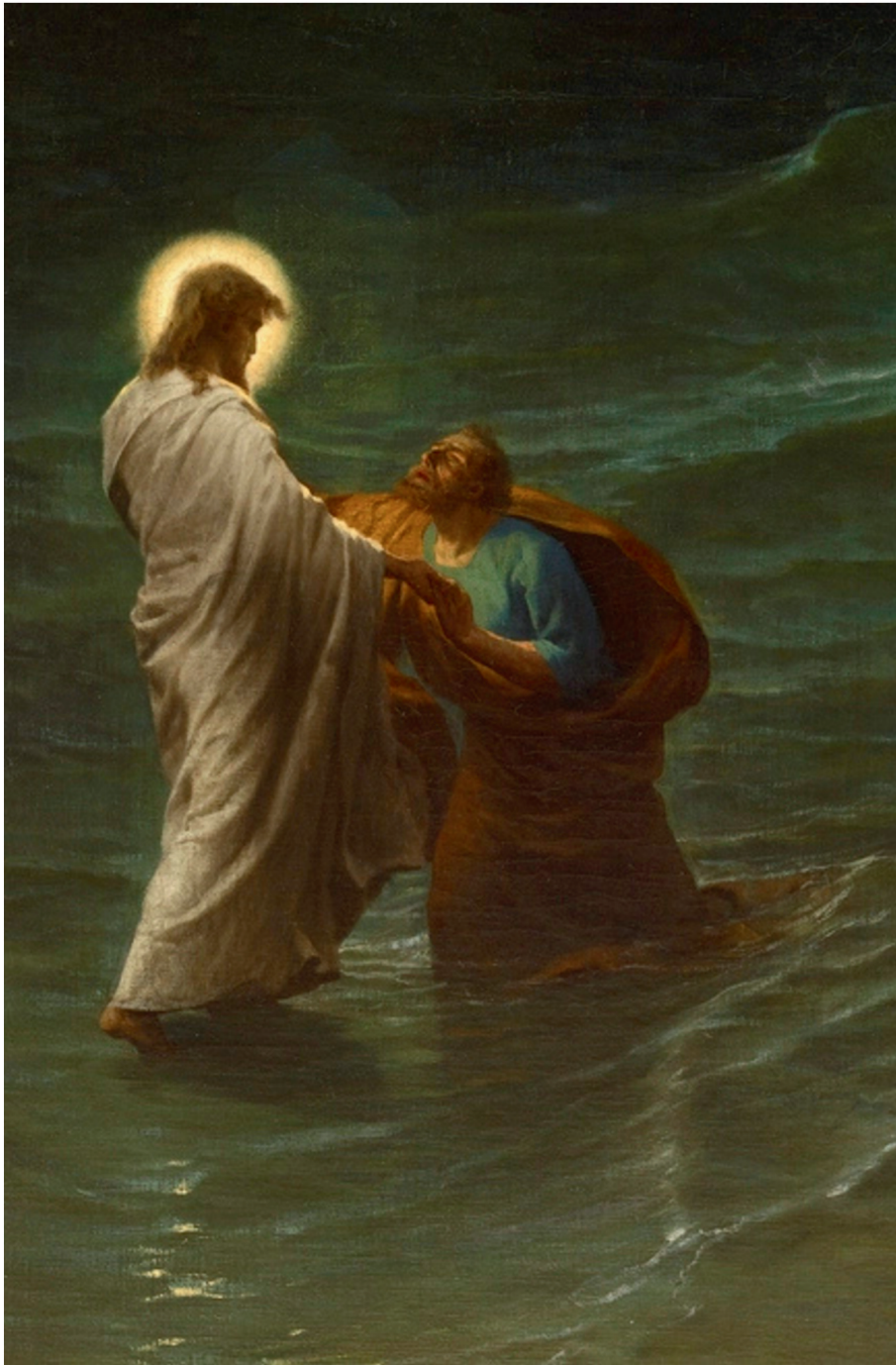

Dear friends in Christ,

First off, a word of thanks to Deacon Tom and the Sister Parish Commission for welcoming Dolores Puértolas and the representatives from La Sagrada Familia parish in the Dominican Republic. We are proud to continue building the friendship in the Lord between the Church in Milwaukee and the Church in Sabana Yegua. This friendship and mutual witness and support is an example of the next principle of Catholic Social Teaching: **solidarity**.

In *Magnifica Humanitas*, Pope Leo XIV wrote that the principle of Solidarity is “the concrete recognition that the future of each individual is connected to the future of all; indeed, ‘no one is saved alone’” (MH #73). Solidarity is both a fact of human society and a virtue. It is a fact that we are born into a network of relationships – no one is conceived alone, we depend on others for our upbringing, for support and help throughout our lives, and as we approach sickness or old age, we rely on others again. To be human is to be in relationship. To be human is to have a history of relying on others and of being responsible for others. This fact is solidarity.

We live solidarity as a virtue when we recognize our interdependence and recognize others as fellow human beings, made in the image of God, who have a claim on our respect and responsibility. To recognize the homeless person as made in the image of God, to acknowledge the human dignity of immigrants both documented and undocumented, to support the pregnant mother and the child in her womb – this is the virtue of solidarity. It doesn't exclude boundaries, but it reminds us that these boundaries should always honor the dignity of the person and promote their wellbeing.

The Cathedral community practices all these forms of solidarity. I invite you to check out the Open Door Café, the Sister Parish Commission, and to form friendships across different language groups. Help the Church to be what she is meant to be – an instrument of peace, a sacrament of communion, a place where we learn the fact and virtue of solidarity.

Queridos amigos en Cristo,

En primer lugar, quiero expresar mi agradecimiento al Diácono Tom y a la Comisión de Parroquia Hermana por dar la bienvenida a Dolores Puértolas y a los representantes de la Parroquia de La Sagrada Familia en la República Dominicana. Nos enorgullece seguir construyendo una amistad en el Señor entre la Iglesia en Milwaukee y la Iglesia en Sabana Yegua. Esta amistad, así como el testimonio y el apoyo mutuo, constituyen un ejemplo del siguiente principio de la Doctrina Social de la Iglesia: la **solidaridad**.

En *Magnifica Humanitas*, el Papa León XIV escribió que el principio de Solidaridad es «el reconocimiento concreto de que el futuro de cada individuo está vinculado al futuro de todos; en efecto, "nadie se salva solo"» (MH #73). La solidaridad es, a la vez, una realidad de la sociedad humana y una virtud. Es un hecho que nacemos dentro de una red de relaciones: nadie es concebido en soledad; dependemos de los demás para nuestra crianza, así como para recibir apoyo y ayuda a lo largo de la vida, y volvemos a depender de otros al llegar a la enfermedad o a la vejez. Ser humano significa vivir en relación con los demás. Ser humano implica tener una historia de dependencia hacia otros y de responsabilidad para con ellos. Esta realidad es la solidaridad.

Vivimos la solidaridad como virtud cuando reconocemos nuestra interdependencia y vemos a los demás como seres humanos, creados a imagen de Dios, que merecen nuestro respeto y responsabilidad. Reconocer a la persona sin hogar como alguien creado a imagen de Dios, valorar la dignidad humana de los inmigrantes, tanto documentados como indocumentados, y apoyar a la madre embarazada y al niño en su vientre: todo esto es la virtud de la solidaridad. Esta no excluye la existencia de fronteras, pero nos recuerda que dichas fronteras siempre deben honrar la dignidad de la persona y promover su bienestar.

La comunidad de la Catedral practica todas estas formas de solidaridad. Les invito a conocer el Open Door Café y la Comisión de la Parroquia Hermana, así como a cultivar amistades entre personas de diferentes grupos lingüísticos. Ayuden a la Iglesia a ser lo que está llamada a ser: un instrumento de paz, un sacramento de comunión y un lugar donde aprendemos tanto la realidad como la virtud de la solidaridad.

Healing the Whole Person: Engaging Your Story

Do you desire healing? Freedom from unhelpful patterns of thought or sin you cannot seem to break. Struggling to understand and help someone else who desires healing or freedom?

Healing the Whole Person: Engaging Your Story is an 8-week series that provides the framework for understanding and receiving Christ's healing and peace in the heart of the Catholic Church.
