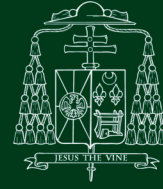

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Dear friends in Christ,



In the news, we hear more and more of the Governor's race and other political battles. With that, it is all the more essential to root ourselves in the **principles of Catholic Social Teaching (CST)**.

I invite you to **scan the QR Code** to look at the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, who articulate CST in seven principles. There are many different ways of naming the principles of CST, but in these bulletin articles, I am following the principles as Pope Leo XIV names them in *Magnifica Humanitas*: the Common Good, the Dignity of the Human Person, the Universal Destination of Goods, Solidarity, and Subsidiarity.

Today we consider the final one: **the principle of subsidiarity**. This states that "the role of individuals, families, local communities and intermediary organizations should not be supplanted by higher-level authorities" (MH #68). In other words, more "local" levels of decision-making should be respected and not usurped by the more "universal" levels. To use an analogy, consider the phrase "helicopter parents." This refers to a parent who constantly "hovers" over their children and does not let their children grow, face obstacles, and make their own decisions. This is the opposite of subsidiarity. Of course, many decisions must and should be made by the parents, but as time goes on and a child grows, the young person can take on more decision-making for themselves. Subsidiarity says large organizations should be managed and governed in ways that foster the responsibility and creativity of those beneath them, so that "decisions are made at the closest level possible to the persons involved" (MH #70).

Subsidiarity is related to the dignity of the human person. It is part of a human person's dignity to have agency, to make decisions, to take responsibility for a sector of the world. The principle of subsidiarity says we should respect that as much as possible, giving as much responsibility and agency to individuals and local communities as possible and helping all people to live in the authority and responsibility that God intended for them.

Queridos amigos en Cristo,



En las noticias, oímos hablar cada vez más de la carrera por la Gobernación y de otras batallas políticas. Por ello, resulta aún más esencial arraigarnos en los **principios de la Doctrina Social de la Iglesia (DSI)**.

Les invito a **escanear el Código QR** para consultar la información de la Conferencia de los Obispos Católicos de Estados Unidos, que articula la DSI en siete principios. Existen diversas formas de denominar los principios de la DSI, pero en estos artículos del boletín sigo la clasificación que el Papa León XIV presenta en *Magnifica Humanitas*: el Bien Común, la Dignidad de la Persona Humana, el Destino Universal de los Bienes, la Solidaridad y la Subsidiariedad.

Hoy abordamos el último de ellos: **el principio de subsidiariedad**. Este establece que "el papel de los individuos, las familias, las comunidades locales y las organizaciones intermediarias no debe ser suplantado por autoridades de nivel superior" (MH #68). En otras palabras, deben respetarse los niveles de toma de decisiones más "locales" y no ser usurpados por los niveles más "universales". A modo de analogía, consideremos la expresión "padres helicóptero". Se refiere a aquellos padres que constantemente "sobrevuelan" a sus hijos/as y no les permiten crecer, afrontar obstáculos ni tomar sus propias decisiones. Esto es lo opuesto a la subsidiariedad. Por supuesto, muchas decisiones deben y tienen que ser tomadas por los padres; sin embargo, a medida que pasa el tiempo y el niño/a crece, el/la joven puede asumir una mayor responsabilidad en la toma de decisiones. La subsidiariedad sostiene que las grandes organizaciones deben gestionarse y gobernarse de manera que fomenten la responsabilidad y la creatividad de quienes dependen de ellas, de modo que "las decisiones se tomen en el nivel más cercano posible a las personas afectadas" (MH #70).

La subsidiariedad está relacionada con la dignidad de la persona humana. Es parte de la dignidad humana tener capacidad de acción, tomar decisiones y asumir la responsabilidad sobre un ámbito del mundo. El principio de subsidiariedad nos dice que debemos respetar esto en la medida de lo posible, otorgando tanta responsabilidad y capacidad de acción como se pueda a los individuos y a las comunidades locales, y ayudando a todas las personas a vivir ejerciendo la autoridad y la responsabilidad que Dios dispuso para ellas.

Come to a **Young Adult Picnic Potluck** event on **Wednesday, August 19, from 5:15 PM to 8:30 PM.**

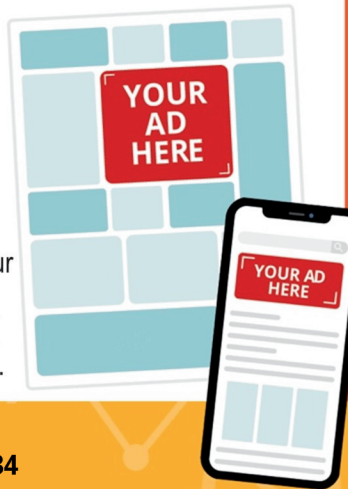

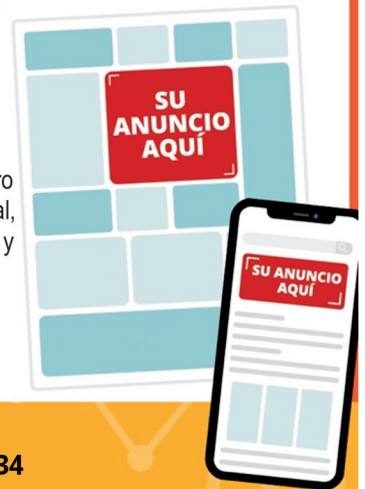


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
