Dear Parishioners,

On the weekend of June 1 & 2, I announced that Fr. Pascal is no longer with us at Annunciation Parish and has completed his service in our diocese. This change brings with it a number of implications for us:

FIRST, it means that you all will have to pray for me! I realize that you pray for me already and I am grateful for your support. Obviously, my responsibility as Pastor of our parish will increase without having an Associate Pastor. So I would be grateful for your continued prayers!

SECOND, it means that we will need to make changes to our weekend Mass schedule. Priests are permitted to celebrate three Masses on the weekend and four with permission from the Bishop, which he has granted, although he also encouraged me to find retired priests to help cover some of those Masses. After consulting various groups and committees in our parish regarding the schedule, I have arrived at the schedule that is printed on the insert this week.

THIRD, it means that we will need to make changes to our weekday Mass schedule. Priests are permitted to celebrate one weekday Mass per day. In addition, because I have the Blessed Sacrament in a chapel in my house I am required to have Mass there at least twice a month. In order to follow these mandates, we will no longer be having a Mass on Monday morning at CTK and we will no longer have Mass on Tuesday evening

at HS. The new weekday Mass schedule is also on the insert. We are fortunate to be in an area where there are a number of options around us for daily Masses.

FOURTH, we will be making some changes to our adoration schedule.

Those changes are also noted on the insert. In conversation with various groups and committees there was a desire for (1) a shorter time of adoration when more people could gather together and (2) an additional time for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Since there will no longer be confessions at CTK on Saturdays, this will serve as another opportunity for the Sacrament.

FINALLY, I realize that change in a parish means adjustments for all of us. If your preferred Mass time changes and you are inconvenienced, please remember that we are working for the good of our whole parish family. My hope is that with one fewer Mass on the weekend we can get to know more people in our parish and make our liturgies a greater celebration of unity.

May the Spirit of the Lord that descended upon the Apostles at Pentecost come down upon us and give us a spirit of openness to the new things to come.

HOUSE OF DISCERNMENT UPDATE

The Father Deydier House of Discernment was opened in August 2018, and since its foundation, has assisted young men discerning Christ's call for their lives.

Following the close of the first academic year program, the House hosted a Mass and cookout for the residents and their families, as well as for friends of the House. More than 225 people attended.



This fall, one House resident will enter seminary for our diocese. Another young man has been attending the House's weekly Monday night Holy Hour & Mass for Vocations since the fall. Having spent time with the House Director and residents each week for formation conferences, Mass and prayer, he has decided to enter the seminary with a Society of Apostolic Life of Pontifical Right this fall. In addition to these two celibate vocations, more than 60 teenage boys attended Savio Night monthly gatherings of faith formation at the House. Savio Night will begin again this fall with the arrival of new House residents.

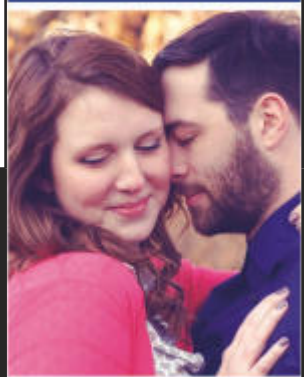
