#### Night #1 - God's Saving Plan

DO YOU KNOW THE SAVING PLAN OF GOD? The first action packed night will take us from Genesis to Jesus in 45 minutes as we gain a simple but challenging understanding of God's plan for our salvation. We will ex-amine the depth of God's love for us and how we can respond to this amazing Grace-filled offer to free us from the bonds of the original and our sin. If you don't know how to explain this saving plan to loved ones, you will want to equip yourself with this knowledge.

#### Night #3 - Living in the Holy Spirit

At this point we are totally all into this journey of faith! This night will turn the corner from sin and brokenness into the profound hope that is offered us in the life and power of the Holy Spirit. We will come to understand how we operate spiritually and why it is so critically important to live in the Life of the Holy Spirit. He is the best kept secret of the Church and we need to learn why. We will follow this evening with a prayer for emotional healing.
