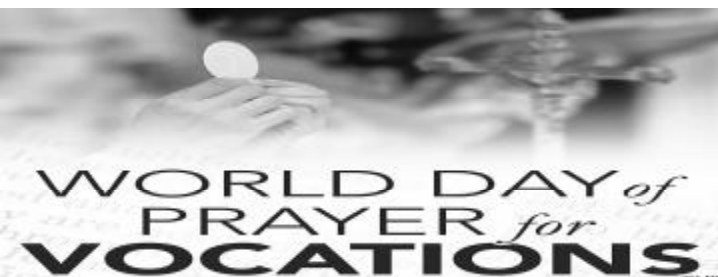

MESSAGE FROM FR. DAREN

Dear brothers and sisters,

I know the announcement I made this past weekend of my coming departure as the Pastor of St. Peter's Parish came as a surprise to many of you, but I am very grateful for the expressions of gratitude and prayers that so many of you shared with me after the Masses; your kindness is much appreciated! We will still have a few more weeks together before I return to The Liturgical Institute in Mundelein, Illinois for my summer studies; let us seek to make the most of them.

This past Wednesday evening we celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation and First Communion with some of our younger parishioners and this coming Wednesday we will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation with our fifth, sixth and seventh graders. It is very good to be able to celebrate these Sacraments again! Please keep these young people in your prayers as they receive the strengthening grace of the Holy Spirit to bear witness to Jesus everywhere they go!

One of the most common questions I am asked in relation to the Sacrament of Confirmation involves the choosing of a "Confirmation Saint," whether it is necessary and why we do it. While doing so is not required, it is a long-standing custom in the Church. The purpose behind choosing a "Confirmation Saint" is to choose a particular Saint as a patron, one with whom a member of the faithful feels a special connection and one whose prayers a member of the faithful desires. At the same time, we should strive to imitate the virtues of our "Confirmation Saint" so that we, too, will one day be brought into the heavenly kingdom. After all, the goal of the Christian life is that each of us become Saints.

Let us keep one another in prayer, asking the Lord to strengthen his grace within us that, relying on the gift of the Holy Spirit we received in Confirmation, we might all be more closely conformed to the heart of Jesus Christ.
